Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

Any party may submit a complaint about a current B Corp through B Lab's Public Complaint Process. Grounds for complaint include:

- 1) Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process

| Summary of Issue   | Luigia Holding SA is a food service and catering company that operates a chain of 11 restaurants in Switzerland and 1 in Dubai. Over the last 5 years, Luigia Holdings has had 2 labor-related litigation cases and 2 labor-related penalty cases:  • Litigation Case 1: A former employee is demanding overtime payment after his dismissal. This case was closed and settled in 2020 with a payment to the former employee.  • Litigation Case 2: A former employee is demanding wrongful termination of the employment contract. After being rejected by the court, the case is still pending appeal from the plaintiff.  • Penalty case 1 & 2: The Company failed to comply with the provisions provided by the Hotel & Restaurant National Collective Agreement Commission in 2023 & 2024 for 2 employees, the discrepancies were in relation to payments in compliance with labor laws and the sector's collective agreement. The company corrected the discrepancies and made the corresponding payments. |
