Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Other - Clients in Controversial Industries

Topic	Clients in Controversial Industries
Summary of Issue	Adviso Conseil is a content and digital marketing firm.
	The company has had clients in the Alcohol, Fossil-Fuel (non-coal/oil sands), Gambling, Payday, Short Term, or High Interest Lending, Pharmaceuticals, Tobacco and Whole life Insurance Product industries which are deemed controversial by B Lab. The services provided to the clients relate to Customer Experiences, Content Marketing, and Data Analytics/Science.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the fiscal year of 2024, the company had generated 0.88% of total revenue from clients in the alcohol industry, 0.22% from clients in the fossil-fuel industry and 0.16% from clients in the Whole life Insurance Product industry.
	The company had last provided services to clients in the gambling and tobacco industry in the year of 2023, and had generated 0.94% of total revenue from clients in the gambling industry and 0.09% of total revenue from clients in the tobacco industry.
	The company had last provided services to clients in the Payday, Short Term or High Interest Lending industry and pharmaceutical industry in the year of 2022, and had generated 0.22% and 0.06% of revenue respectively.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
	B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
Implemented Management Practices	Adviso Conseil currently does not have a formal position on working with sensitive industries or a policy to move away from them. However, the company has recently excluded certain



industries such as pornography and tobacco from its potential client lists.

The company uses its formal Decision-Making Filter in deciding to work with potential clients. The filter is used to assess the potential clients'/suppliers' commitment towards Environmental, social, and governance (ESG). If the business partners have an ESG policy in place in their organization and helds the same values as Adviso Conseil, the chances of being accepted as client/supplier is higher.

As Adviso Conseil works mainly with regional small businesses, they are aware of the services provided by their potential clients and are therefore able to assess whether the services are being used in ways that could harm people or the environment.

Management Comments

Adviso has created a decision-making filter used by the Executive committee to take its various stakeholders into account when making decisions. The decision-making filter is a framework that enables Adviso to materialize its ESG commitment through a series of questions to be asked when making strategic decisions. These questions are based on the five evaluation criteria of the B Corp certification. This tool is the first step in ensuring that clients' choices are in line with Adviso's responsible values. Other initiatives will be rolled out over the next few years to improve Adviso's practices.
