



## DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

<b>DISCLOSURE QUESTIONNAIRE CATEGORY</b>	Animal Products and Services
<b>TOPIC</b>	Company operates a honey farm and has direct control over the treatment of bees in its care.
<b>SUMMARY OF ISSUE</b>	Bee Squared is involved in the production and sale of pure varietal Honey, and other bee products and bee based products.
<b>SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE</b> (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Bee Squared has 125 hives in various locations in Weld, Larimer and Boulder counties. The company manages 150 colonies from Denver to Wellington, covering a distance of approximately 75 miles. The colonies are kept in urban, suburban and rural areas. There are bee yards ranging from 2 colonies to 16 colonies. An average of 50,000 bees reside within a colony.
<b>IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS</b>	Bee Squared spreads out bees across the landscape to ensure adequate resources. Industrially managed acreage is avoided to limit bee exposure to chemical pesticides. When honey supers are removed, adequate honey is left in brood chambers for the colony as well as sufficient resources in the environment for them to continue to forage and bulk up for the winter. Based on weight measurement, Bee Squared feeds sugar in the spring and in the fall, if necessary.
<b>IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES</b>	<p>Weekly inspections during the spring ensure that bees are healthy and disease-free. European Foulbrood disease, (of the few visible bee diseases) is treated by removing the contaminated frames and replacing them with uncontaminated ones until the colony is able to control the problem by itself.</p> <p>The company does not use any plastic in its colonies; wax and wire are used instead.</p> <p>The company owner has founded a non-profit called ""People and Pollinators Action Network (PPAN)"" to promote planting of pollinator habitat and is Treasurer of the non-profit Pollinator Stewardship Council.</p>
