Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Suppliers in Conflict Zones

Topic	Humans in the Loop has partnerships with NGOs that operate in conflict zones.
Summary of Issue	Humans in the Loop is a company set in Sofia, Bulgaria, that provides opportunities to individuals with barriers to employment such as immigrants, displaced persons, or refugees in partnership with non-profit organizations. They offer annotation services to several industries. The company currently has suppliers that operate in Syria, Iraq, Afghanistan, Ukraine, and the DRC, which are countries listed in the World Bank's "Fragile and conflict-affected situations list". Humans in the Loop partners with local or international NGOs and social enterprises so as to provide work and training opportunities to local communities. The company does not provide any paid services and products in these countries. All of its programs are free to access and its main goal is to generate opportunities for livelihoods and upskilling in these difficult environments.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company does not have any revenues coming from conflict zones. Instead, it generates its revenues from clients in the EU and US. The company provides income to its workers and trainees in conflict zones.
Impact on Stakeholders	As per the OECD, conflict zones are often characterized by widespread human rights abuses and violations of national or international law. The security of company workers who work in such areas could also be at risk.
Management Practices	The company has implemented the following practices in the conflict zones from which they source: - Anti-money laundering policy which regulates the company relationships with local organizations. - Its local partners conduct background checks on all trainees and workers. - It has a Beneficiary Advisory Board with representatives from each country which ensures that the company's strategic objectives are in line with the community's priorities and needs. - It has a Health and safety training for all employees.

Management Comments	"Our mission as an organization is to operate with conflict-affected communities, which includes refugees, internally displaced persons, and those residing in post-conflict or active conflict areas. Currently we have operations in conflict zones such as Syria, Iraq, Afghanistan, Ukraine, and the DRC, and it's on our roadmap to also scale to other areas of conflict in order to support people who live there. Our support is in the form of access to livelihoods, payment methods, and upskilling activities for the most vulnerable who are at risk of unemployment and who may be forced to flee their home countries because of the combination of conflict and economic stagnation."
