## **Disclosure Questionnaire Statement**

**Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Environmentally Intensive Industries** 

Topic	Energy and Emissions Intensive Industries
Summary of Issue	The Netlogix Group operates in the logistics and transport industry; an industry where energy consumption and emissions are a significant environmental issue. The Group is asset lite, being a digital freight management company, connecting shippers with freight to carriers with capacity to move freight. Whilst all freight movement is performed by third parties, the Group does lease some cars (<10), forklifts (<10), office space and a warehouse facility (<10,000 sqm). The leased warehouse facility is used for Cross-Docking (receiving inbound products and transferring to outbound transportation either directly or indirectly) and holds some customer products in storage.  The Group provides a unique technology-enabled domestic freight management solution to customers (shippers) offering them access to a wide range of carriers, aggregating loads and facilitating optimization (e.g. network and configuration optimization). This recognizes, and starts to address, inherent inefficiencies in the freight solutions typically offered in the market.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of the company's revenue is derived from the logistics and transport industry. >98% of the company's total emissions are Scope 3 Emissions. Netlogix's Carbon Intensity per Freight Unit (tCO2e per FU) in 2023 was calculated as 0.020593.
Impact on Stakeholders	The logistics and transport industry is both resource intensive as well as energy and emissions intensive.
Implemented Management Practices	Netlogix commenced its emissions reduction journey in 2019 by firstly measuring its emissions (scope 1, 2 & 3) before setting achievable targets to reduce scope 1 & 2 emissions. Netlogix as a member of, and contributor to, the Sustainable Business Council (SBC) and a signatory to the Climate Leaders Coalition (CLC) in New Zealand, and as members the emission reduction targets set met the requirements set out by the CLC and SBC.



	The emissions inventory, the reduction targets and the performance against those targets have been publicly reported on Netlogix's website. The achieved reduction in emissions has been from the removal of fossil fuels from our own business; and from the introduction of energy efficient lighting and Material Handling Equipment (MHE) in our Cross-Dock and Warehouse facility.
	Netlogix's freight platform targets efficiencies, meaning we move more freight with less trucks, saving empty kilometers/dead-legs meaning fewer empty kilometers across the freight network, this productivity from optimisation all reduces unnecessary carbon emissions.
