The company voluntarily tests on animals A balanced animal feed manufacturing company, Alimentos Balanceados Crecer is dedicated to formulating, producing and selling balanced feed to animal producers (e.g. sheep). Although animal testing is not required by law in the jurisdiction where the company produces and sells its products, the company carries out testing to a minimum in order to generate original information demonstrating the modality of use and measuring production results, contributing to the improvement of animal production, particularly in Patagonia. In 2022 the percentage of products that were tested on animals represented 0.011% of the company's annual revenue Animal testing and experimentation is widely used to develop and test the safety of new healthcare and/or food products.  The company has a Policy on Animal Testing where it commits to conducting noninvasive testing methods and use of alternative methods where possible. AB Crecer reported that there are alternative methods to study foods without the use of animals, such as digestibility, gas production, and proteins, but these methods depend a lot on the conditions where they are tested and make it difficult to extrapolate the results to productive aspects. In this sense, in vitro studies are complementary to animal studies. The company tests the amount of food on animals to a minimum and only does so when it is required to generate original information and with the aim of contributing to the improvement of animal production and welfare, particularly in Patagonia. The information generated is public and is communicated through presentations and publications in AAPA (Argentine Association of Animal Production) in most cases. The animal testing carried out to test the feed is carried out by an accredited institution called INTA (Instituto Nacional de Tecnología Agropecuaria). AB Crecer has a signed agreement with INTA and provides food to carry out the testing. INTA currently has a CICUAE in each region (Regional Committee for the Care and Use of Experimental Animals) where it endorses each work with the use of animals. Trials or tests are not performed as part of a product development process. For their formulation, the available and approved raw materials are considered and combined in such a way as to cover the requirements or needs of the animals. Given that the specific tests are carried out to demonstrate results or find solutions that facilitate the production and care of their clients' farm.
