

Entry to Machu Picchu is only possible through defined circuits, and your ticket determines the route you can follow.

Entry times: Strictly scheduled – morning or afternoon shifts Daily quota: Limited to 4,500 visitors per day (subject to official updates)

Advance booking: Recommended 2 to 4 months in advance.

Access: By train + bus, or through multi-day treks (Inca Trail, Salkantay, Lares, among others) Available Circuits (Mandatory Routes).



CIRCUIT 1 Upper Panoramic

Route: Upper area of Machu Picchu, agricultural terraces, and classic viewpoints.

Ideal for: Visitors seeking panoramic views and the iconic postcard photo of the sanctuary.

Difficulty: Moderate.

Does not include: Access to Huayna Picchu or Machu Picchu Mountain.





CIRCUIT 3

Lower Circuit (Temples and Terraces)

Route: Lower part of the citadel, with access to temples, plazas, and agricultural zones.
Ideal for: Visitors who prefer a closer experience with the ceremonial and agricultural areas.



Temperate Valley - QUECHUA

4.100 - 4.800 m

Begin your journey in the Quechua region, following the Urubamba River from Pisac to Machu Picchu. Explore monumental Inca architecture and remote ruins like Pumamarca, wander colorful markets and village alleys, and immerse yourself in the vibrant daily life and rich culture of Andean communities.

Intermediate Region- SUNI

3.500 - 4.100 m

Above the Sacred Valley, Suni reveals panoramic views of rolling plains and deep gorges, reflecting the vertical dimension central to Inca culture. Explore Moray's experimental terraces, the Salineras de Maras, and Tipón's ancient channels, still in use today. One to two nights of acclimatization are recommended for high-altitude expeditions.

High Plateau - PUNA

4.100 - 4.800 m

Discover life at high altitude, where glaciers and peaks inspire the cult of the Apus. Vast prairies stretch across lagunas, potato fields, shepherd huts, and glacial streams. Follow narrow mountain trails, breathe deeply, and enjoy the panoramic views and colors of the high Andes.


