## **Disclosure Materials**

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process

## **Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Supply Chain Disclosure**

Topic	Suppliers in the Mining Industry
Summary of Issue	Arte Groep is a remodeling company that uses granite and marble in its projects.
	Arte Groep has taken steps to ensure the raw materials it purchases are fully traceable and have third-party certifications verifying that they are ethically sourced. The materials are sourced from natural stone quarries in India, Italy, and Belgium.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	7% of the company's Cost of Goods Sold comes from raw materials that would be considered of high social and environmental risk, including marble and granite.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that purchase mineral resources such as marble and granite have a higher risk of encountering social and environmental issues in their supply chains. Specifically, biodiversity risks, human rights violations, and contributions that fund armed conflict (directly or indirectly) are material risks present in the industry.
Implemented Management Practices	To manage the risks involved in the supply chain, Arte Groep has the XertifiX-seal. XertifiX is an NGO that conducts on-site audits and offers a certificate as proof of responsible action (CSR) for companies. Aspects considered in the audits include: Environmental Management System, Pollution and Waste Management, Installation of a grievance mechanism for affected communities, Living conditions of the workers (if accommodation is provided), Ecosystem and protected areas, and Energy Management.  In addition to the audits conducted by XertifiX, Arte Groep makes regular visits to their suppliers and the quarries to verify if the activities conducted are in compliance with the Code of Conduct signed between both parties. Arte Groep is also part of the Fund Against Child Labour, which monitors that no
	violations in this regard are committed.  Arte Groep signed the TruStone Initiative Agreements regarding responsible business conduct in the natural stone sector, led by the Dutch and Flemish governments.



	Beyond that, the company claims to be looking for other alternative materials to granite, such as composite and ceramic. As a result, they expect their sales of worktops made of granite to become smaller in the coming years.
