Topic	Negative news involving company's parent company
Summary of Issue	Naturalia is a wholly-owned subsidiary of the French mass- market supermarket group, Casino. Casino has been threatened with legal action by a coalition of NGOs who accuse it of sourcing and selling products linked to illegal deforestation in the Amazon Rainforest. Naturalia prioritizes the purchase plant based products and the
	meat products they sell are organic and of French origin.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Given the certified entity is Naturalia, B Lab has only considered how the negative news could affect the company's business strategy. The impact of these statements to the Casino business strategy will be separately assessed and reviewed when and if the Casino Group joins B Lab's certification process.
	In 2020, the period concerning the article, Naturalia had two suppliers of meat and beef, both French and both organic certified, sold under the brands Comptoir des Viandes and Monfort Viande through a joint venture. Naturalia is committed to engage meat range suppliers that are local with organic certified products.
	Currently the company sells 3 Naturalia branded meat products (see links below) and derives 2.65% of revenue from the sale of meat products that are organic and from French origin.
Impact on Stakeholders	Naturalia is part of the Casino group and the parent's supply chain practices could have a reputational impact on the company.
	Naturalia's purchasing is independent of that of the Casino Group, they have their own teams of buyers and category managers who work with specific suppliers on a specific offering; they do not have any joint suppliers.
	As this case involved the parent company and Naturalia's suppliers were not concerned, there was no public communication from Naturalia.



	Over the past five years, and since its inception Naturalia has not faced any public stakeholder concerns related to deforestation in its supply chain.
Implemented Management Practices	Naturalia has in place a Sustainable Purchases Matrix that establishes: - The preference of purchases from France and when this is not possible, from Italy or Spain. - Avoid purchases from countries outside of and close to France such as Eastern Europe or International. - Aim for purchases from suppliers located near processing locations and create partnerships with cooperatives. - Aim for purchases of raw materials with a processing list that is as short as possible Naturalia is making an active effort to raise awareness internally among their teams and externally about the impact of deforestation through the "Climate Fresco", (which they have carried out regularly and have run events for 378 people since 2023) and the "Forest Fresco" run for head office teams by their partner association 'Coeur de forêt' (see link below for more
