

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	The company was in a bankrupcy position back in 2017, losing 350K€ / year. It was losing money on every B2C sale. As a result the CEO had to cut as many jobs as possible in order to maintain the activity while having fewer losses. 1. All key contact with the company were reduced to their bear minimum. As a result, several issues appeared such as: - inventory shortage - change and concentration of contacts during the tough times - decrease and reduction of regular communication to B2C customers - change in commication towards end users - change of marketing tone of voice from product orineted communication to sustainability oriented messages 2. 2 people were laid off at that time.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE	2 ampleyees were laid off representing 200/ of the company's ampleyees at that time
(e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	2 employees were laid off, representing 28% of the company's employees at that time.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDER(S)	2 employees laid off
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	As part of the conventional termination, payment to Pôle Emploi to accompany the employees but none had any problems finding work afterwards. Employees were given better compensation than economic dismissal, and the company negotiated amicable departures, Chacun Son Cafe also put employees in touch with other professionals in the sector.
