Topic	Litigation and Penalties related to Employee Dismissal, Workplace Accidents, Occupational Health & Safety, and Non-Compliance with Employment matters
Summary of Issue	 Constructora Oval has had 86 labor lawsuits, of which: 63 are for unfair dismissal: 51 have been settled by agreement; 1 was rejected by the court; 3 were dismissed, 2 were settled by judgment (one in favor and one against), and 6 lawsuits are pending. 5 are protection suits: Of which 3 have been settled by agreement, and 2 are pending. 16 are for work-related accidents: Of which 9 have been settled by judgment (5 with payment, 5 without payment), 5 have been settled by agreement, and 2 are pending. 1 for annulment of dismissal is pending. 1 for the collection of benefits settled by agreement. Also, in the last 5 years, the company has had 6 civil lawsuits: 1 for annulment of sale, settled by agreement. 1 Compliance with Judgment. In progress. 1 Collection of Withholdings. In progress. 2 Consumer Law. Abandoned by the plaintiffs. 1 Executive Judgment. Judgment favorable to OVAL.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Each of the lawsuits resolved through settlement or judgment represented less than 1% of the company's total revenue at the end of the last fiscal year. The total amount paid directly by OVAL in lawsuits (excluding those covered by insurance) represents 0.9% of total cumulative revenue from 2020 to 2024 (5 years reported). Regarding the pending cases, the estimated value of each case
Impact on Stakeholders	represents less than 1% of the company's annual revenue. The primary impact related to the labor litigations & penalties is the financial impact and risks related to employee safety issues. The impact related to contract disputes and non-compliance



	with employee documentation is the reputational and financial risks to all the parties involved, including the company.
Resolution	Of the 75 labor lawsuits concluded, 80% were resolved by settlement, 5.3% by dismissal or dismissal, and 14.6% by judgment. Both settlements and judgments were fully satisfied.
	Of the six civil lawsuits, 25% were resolved by settlement, 50% by the plaintiff's abandonment of the proceedings, and 25% by favorable judgment.
Implemented Management Practices	The company has made changes to its dismissal policies and procedures to reduce unfair dismissal claims. Indeed, a Termination Procedure was established; a requirement was implemented that the Technical Works Inspector (external to SERVIU) sign the Gantt Charts at the end of the corresponding tasks. These are also published on the bulletin boards at each job site so that all workers are aware of them.
	Regarding reducing lawsuits for work-related accidents, worker safety procedures were improved, and new safety training was conducted. An annual strategy was established to measure accident and accident rate indicators on construction sites. The Tazki platform was implemented to detect occupational hazards and correct them immediately. Safety incentive activities were implemented on construction sites, as well as strategic occupational health and safety workshops.
	This has allowed the company to reduce the certified accident, accident rate, and severity rates, as recorded in the Mutual de Seguridad Accident Certificate. The company has also since obtained: Joint Work Committee Certification, the CCHC Safety and Health Best Practices Award, the Elige Bienestar Program, and the Strategic Safety and Health Training Program.
	For the penalties, the company makes corrections according to the labor inspector's observations. The company has now corrected the following findings from the inspection;
	 Not taking the necessary protective measures Not having visible and permanent signage in danger zones Not keeping proper attendance records Failure to remove hazard factors in the workplace



- Do not generate the determination of working hours
- Failure to report occupational hazards
- Failure to take the necessary measures to protect the lives of workers
- Failure to display all documentation in the conciliation process
- Not having sanitary services according to legal requirements
- Failure to keep electrical or gas installations protected
- Do not place fire extinguishers in visible places
- Failure to report an accident or occupational disease to the administrative body
- Not providing workers with personal protective equipment free of charge
- Failure to maintain optimal safety conditions at work
