Disclosure Materials

Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

B Lab's Public Complaints Process

Any party may submit a complaint about a current B Corp through B Lab's Public Complaint Process. Grounds for complaint include:

- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process
- 2) Breaches of the B Corp Community's core values as expressed in our Declaration of Interdependence

Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the last fiscal year, 15.24% of the company's annual revenue was from clients in the tobacco industry.	
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can directly or indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. Companies offering certain types of services and products to controversial clients are required to have at a minimum a grievance/complaints mechanism and a whistleblower protection policy.	
Implemented Management Practices	GRUNER has the following mechanisms in place to manage the risks related to its business relationships with clients in the controversial and ineligible industry: Grievance/complaints mechanism. This is accessible to the public through the company's main webpage under the "Ethics and Whistleblower Channel" section. The section would direct complainants to an online form where they can fill out the details of the grievance. They can also reach out through email: denuncias@gruner.mx. Both channels will be under the direct supervision of the Ethics Committee. Complainants can raise

received by the Ethics Committee is recorded in an internal monitoring system with strict security measures. Within 3 business days, an acknowledgment of receipt will be sent if the report is not anonymous. Complainants sending reports anonymously also have the option of providing their contact information if they wish to receive an update. The company will respond within 3 working days and let them know of the next steps. Whistleblower Protection Policy. The policy includes the following statements: • The company does not tolerate retaliation against whistleblowers. The whistleblower affected by retaliation must notify the Ethics Committee. The Committee will investigate the case and take immediate measures to stop the reprisals. Sanctions will be implemented against those who have engaged in retaliation, depending on the severity of the case. Full protection of the whistleblower's identity and the information provided. The identity of the whistleblower will be protected at all times, unless the person consents to its disclosure or it is required by law.
