DISCLOSURE QUESTIONNAIRE CATEGORY	Grupo Laguna
TOPIC	Water Intensive Industries
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a construction company, Grupo Laguna operates in an industry that is water intensive. Aspects of the civil construction industry that make it water intensive include water used for concrete production for all the stages of containment, foundation and structure, masonry sealing, and coating.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company derived 100% of its revenue from the construction segment in 2021.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Water-intensive industries pose risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. The company sources its water from Curitiba's public network (Sanepar), water from reuse systems installed on construction sites, water from artesian wells built on the construction sites themselves, and water from water tankers, extracted from wells. Curitiba is not considered a water-stressed area, however low rainfall rates have affected the level of the reservoirs that supply the city of Curitiba, causing water rationing in the city. To mitigate this problem artesian wells are constructed on the construction sites and are using water from tanker trucks, which are supplied by reuse sources or from other water sources. Of the projects incorporated by Laguna, 7 (Iguaçu 2820, Mai Home, Mai Terraces, Ampio, BIOOS, PINAH and Vaz) of the 9 projects delivered from 2013 have an artesian well.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Grupo Laguna does not currently have reduction targets nor asssesses how it compares with others in the industry; yet the company monitors its consumption and is studying its scenario to define targets.  All the projects have some kind of environmental certification that require that the construction work and especially the operation (post construction) to have excellent indexes of low consumption.  The certifications that Laguna possesses for thier projects include LEED and GBC.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a construction company, Grupo Laguna operates in an industry in which energy and carbon emissions are material environmental issues. Aspects of the industry that make it energy and emissions-intensive include the use of machinery and building materials.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company derived 100% of its revenue from the construction segment in 2021.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As an energy-intensive industry, construction poses risks such as energy waste or overuse if this resource is not appropriately managed.
	The company's main source of energy comes from the electrical grid of the concessiony that serves the city of Curitiba (Copel).  Sometimes generators are used, fueled with biodiesel, but these are rare cases.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The company seeks to use equipment with low energy consumption and in relation to carbon emissions the company aims to use industrialized and rationalized constructive systems, reducing waste disposal and using recycled material. Grupo Laguna carried out a GHG Inventory Report for the year 2021, which is currently in process of validation, after which the company aims to determine emissions mitigation/reduction targets. In 2021 Grupo Laguna neutralized its Scope 1 and 2 emissions.
	The company does not currently carry out an assessment of how it compares to others in its industry in relation to energy consumption and emissions.
	The company T2H Ambiental was contracted by Laguna to prepare the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions inventory of Laguna in 2021 based on scopes 1 and 2 through the Brazilian GHG Protocol Program methodology, compatible with ISO 14064 and Panel guidelines Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC).
	The company's emissions, considering the base year 2021, were 68.93 tons of CO2. Of these emissions, 25.55 tons of CO2 (37.1%) are Scope 1 emissions and 43.38 tons of CO2 (62.9%) are Scope 2 emissions.
	Laguna opted to neutralize carbon emissions through the acquisition of carbon credits from the CDM/UNFCCC standard project (Clean Development Mechanism of the Kyoto Protocol, UN) of the project for the collection and burning of biogas generated at the Landfill of Paulínia, purchasing in Feb/2023 140 CERs equivalent to 140 tons of CO2 according to the VOLUNTARY CANCELLATION CERTIFICATE of the United Nations Framework onvention Climate Change Reference: VC/0107/2023. As a result, the 2021 emissions in Scope 1 and 2 were neutralized, leaving a balance of 71.07 CERs for the year 2022, still without an inventory.
