Issue Date	December 2018 & August 2023
Topic	Litigation related to labor issues.
Summary of Issue	In two separate incidents, the company underwent litigation related to the dismissal of two employees. The first incident was related to a dismissal due to disciplinary misconduct and the other was in regard to the dismissal of a managing director of a company formally belonging to the Group.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Both cases were settled with an agreed upon payment totaling approximately \$230,000.
Impact on Stakeholders	Primary impact was loss of employment for affected employees.
Resolution	Both cases were settled with a payment from the company to the former employees.
Management Practices	Following these incidents, the company conducted an internal discussion and analysis of the issue at the Board level. The company then conducted additional management training and improved their hiring process which includes providing space for feedback.
