

# **Score Aggregation Methodology & Brand List La Marzocco Group 2026**

As the B Corporation Certification is a company-level certification, the assessment of a Parent Company is required to include its subsidiaries in which it owns directly or indirectly >50% of the shares and has a controlling interest. Depending on the operations of the certifying company, Parent Companies may roll up their direct or indirect subsidiaries into a single assessment or assess separately.

Regardless of whether a Certified Parent Company’s subsidiaries are assessed together or separately, only distinct direct or indirect subsidiaries that B Lab has determined independently meet the performance requirement for certification (i.e. score of 80+ points) are eligible to use the Certified B Corporation logo and refer to themselves as Certified B Corporations.

### **Aggregated Scoring Methodology**

La Marzocco International L.L.C. and its direct or indirect subsidiary/ies were required to be assessed in the B Impact Assessment and undergo a review by B Lab staff. The entities were divided into 3 assessments, and the overall score was calculated using a weighted average based on HEADCOUNT.

The assessments are as follows:

1. BIA #1 Europe and Oceania
2. BIA #2 USA
3. BIA #3 (La Marzocco Shanghai + SG + ME)

Based on the weighted average, La Marzocco Group scored an overall 84.4 out of 200 total available points. The minimum verified score required for B Corp Certification is 80.

The table below shows the scores for the individual assessments:

**Brands**

Brands that are not distinct operating subsidiaries included in the Parent Company’s certification are not Certified B Corporations themselves but may use the Certified B Corporation logo if B Lab has determined they have independently met the performance requirement for certification. Otherwise, the Certified B Corporation logo shall only be used in reference to the brand as part of the Parent Company’s certification. For a list of brands under La Marzocco Group that have been determined to have met the performance standards for certification (i.e. score of 80+ points) independently and can therefore use the B Corp IP, see the table below.

**Entities**

For a list of legal entities under La Marzocco Group that have been determined to have met the performance standards for certification (i.e. score of 80+ points) independently, even if such companies do not include the name “La Marzocco” in their corporate name, and can therefore use the B Corp IP, see the table below.
