Summary of Issue	The company has two arbitration cases related to employee workplace accidents.
	In one incident, an employee slipped on spillage in the company factory and in another incident, an employee was injured while lifting a bin.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The value of each of the cases were less than 1% of the company's total revenue in the year of reference.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	The primary impact relates to employee safety.
Resolution	The incident related to the employee's fall was settled with payment and the incident related to an employee injury while lifting a bin is still under the arbitration process pending a final outcome.
Implemented Management Practices	To mitigate similar incidents, the company regularly reviews and revises as appropriate its health and safety procedures. The company also ensures all employees are trained by a Health and Safety manager.
