Summary of Issue	Nimble ELearning Ltd provides e-learning products and services. The company offers both a platform and guidance for clients to create essential and mandatory training courses as well as off-the-shelf e-learning courses covering a wide range of compliance areas including health and safety, staff well-being, and social responsibility. Over the last 5 years, Nimble has served clients operating in the Alcohol, Gambling, Nuclear Power or Hazardous Materials, Tax Advisory Service and Zoos, Aquariums and Animal Parks industries. Services offered to these clients can be sold to both clients in controversial as well as non-controversial industries. The company no longer serves clients operating in the Gambling industry.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Clients operating in controversial industries represented the following % of the company's FY2023 revenue: - Alcohol industry, 0.61% - Gambling industry, 0.16%. The company has stopped serving this industry since 2022. - Nuclear Power or Hazardous Materials industry, 3.67%. - Tax Advisory Services, 0.20% - Zoos, aquariums and animal parks, 0%.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
Implemented Management Practices	The company does not currently have a position on working with clients in controversial industries, nor have an industry exclusion list. However Nimble ELearning Ltd will engage with clients who can clearly demonstrate a commitment to their core values and B Corp principles, including ethical business practices, sustainability, and social responsibility. While they prioritise partnerships with companies dedicated to making a positive impact, they implement regular audits and reviews to ensure that their current and future clients continue to meet

their core values and standards.

	Nimble ELearning Ltd has an 'Ethical Client Engagement Process' (see link below). This is the company's due diligence process which includes an onboarding disclosure questionnaire designed to protect the company's integrity and ensure they work with clients who share their commitment to ethical practices and sustainability. In line with this commitment, during its onboarding process into its CRM, if it is detected that a potential client either operates in a sensitive or controversial industry, or has reported negative practices over the last 5 years, the client needs to complete a form for further approval. The form requests information about the controversial industries the client works with as well as their respective role in those industries as well as requiring a disclosure of sensitive practices subject to stakeholder concern. The final decision on whether to continue forward with a client is made by the company's B Corp Champions and Senior Management. In addition, the company has an 'Ethical Partnership and Collaboration Policy' which ensures that if a partnership presents ethical concerns, the final decision will rest with their senior leadership team, who will balance the long-term value of the relationship with their mission and values (see link below). There are certain practices that Nimble ELearning Ltd will not tolerate under any circumstances, such as human rights abuses (e.g. child labour, forced labour, unsafe working conditions), severe environmental harm (e.g. significant pollution without a credible plan to mitigate or repair the damage), corruption and unethical business practices (e.g. fraud, exploitation).
