Topic	Coffee bean purchases from areas of conflict zones
Summary of Issue	Single O Wholesale Pty Ltd is a Coffee Roaster located in NSW, Australia that sources its coffee beans from small-scale farmers, cooperatives and importers in the regions of Ethiopia, Burundi, and Papua New Guinea. Ethiopia is considered a Conflict Zone, and Burundi, and Papua New Guinea considered Institutional and Social Fragility countries, according to the World Bank's FCS List (2024).
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the last fiscal year the company's coffee purchases from Ethiopia represented 4.54% of total purchases, purchases made in Burundi represented approximately 0.2%, and purchases made in Papua New Guinea represented approximately 20.86%.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	High-risk supply chains, such as coffee, have a history of forced and child labor, which subjects workers to poor working conditions, low wages, and puts children at risk for human trafficking. As per the OECD, conflict zones are often characterized by widespread human rights abuses and violations of national or
	international law.
Implemented Management Practices	The company does supplier screening via supplier documents and have their Head of Coffee visiting farms and meeting producers in person.
	The company has a Supplier disclosure required if they operate in conflict zones, ensuring that: - Suppliers don't contribute to or exacerbate existing conflict through their operations - Supplier's operations do not violate human rights - Supplier's operation does not support or sanction illegal activities
	The company has a Supplier Code of Conduct and Ethics and Supplier Checklist that all suppliers need to complete. This covers environmental impact, safety, governance and human



rights.

100% of the coffee beans can be traced back to the source. 20% of the coffee beans are sourced from importers and 80% is directly from the origin.

Papua New Guinea suppliers – Organic, Fairtrade, Rainforest Alliance

Ethiopia suppliers – Rain Forest Alliance, Fair Trade, Organic, Ecovadis

Burundi suppliers – WCPP (Women Coffee Producer Program), Fairtrade, SMS (Sustainable Services Management), UTZ, Rainforest Alliance, Organic
