

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a food producer (mushrooms), NÃM operates in an industry that is water intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 49.46% of NÃM's revenue was earned from the sale of mushrooms.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water intensive industry, food manufacturers poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. NÃM uses water from EPAL of the municipality of Lisbon.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	 Company tracks the water use through a management system and is able to determine their water usage as 25 liters of water per kg of mushroom; NÃM is currently planning to reuse water from the production to clean the equipment and machinery in order to minimize water usage.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a food producer (mushrooms), NÃM uses energy in their process to grow their products and therefore NÃM operates in an energy and emissions intensive industry.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 49.46% of NÃM's revenue was earned from the sale of mushrooms.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a energy intensive industry, food producing processes pose risks such as energy waste or overuse if this resource is not appropriately managed.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	 NÃM uses energy from EDP utility, which has 60% of its energy from solar/wind sources; Company tracks their energy usage and have positive carbon offset mainly to the use of coffee waste in their production process; Company is developing a method to pre-warm the substrate before the sterilization process in order to minimize energy consumption.; NÃM uses high tech precision machinery, programmed by computer, which helps to minimize energy use to maintain the expected conditions inside the production rooms.
OTHER MANAGEMENT COMMENTS	- Nam is developing solar panels for its new Nam Labs production units
