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Disclosure Materials

Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

B Lab's Public Complaints Process

Any party may submit a complaint about a current B Corp through B Lab's Public Complaint Process. Grounds for complaint include:

- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process
- Breaches of the B Corp Community's core values as expressed in our Declaration of Interdependence

| Impact on Stakeholders | Businesses have an obligation to contribute its share of taxes. This is because business exists within the context of society; its proper role is to serve society, not the other way around. Moreover, healthy businesses can only exist over the long term in a healthy society. A healthy society depends upon public expenditures made possible by taxes. These public expenditures benefit business in both direct and indirect ways. B Lab recognizes fair payment of taxes as a material business issue and has a Framework for Evaluating Tax Strategies for B Corp Certification. |
| Implemented Management Practices | Brighton Jones's services are consistent with the principles that (1) the amount of overall taxes paid over time appropriately reflects the actual amount of income generated by the client, and (2) the amount of taxes paid over time in each jurisdiction appropriately reflects the actual operations of the client in that jurisdiction. The company conducts OFAC / KYC / AML criminal screenings, performed by their brokerage partners; Brighton Jones ensures that they do not participate in any money laundering, tax evasion, or terrorist financing. The company also has a tax philosophy statement, which includes their code of ethics that outlines its commitment as a fiduciary to clients to help ensure all employees act with integrity, transparency, and compliance with applicable laws. All employees must acknowledge these requirements within two weeks upon being hired, and annually thereafter as updates are made to the Brighton Jones Compliance Manual. |
