SUMMARY OF ISSUE	Las Leñas Servicios Ejecutivos S.R.L. is dedicated to the transfer of people by means of cars and minibuses which are powered by fossil fuels and compressed natural gas (CNG) and are therefore recognised as a carbon intensive industry. In 2019, the company conducted an assessment of their carbon emissions and in April 2020, they were certified carbon neutral.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The total energy intensity of the company during 2019 was 793.9 TN. CO2e. - Energy consumption in offices was 22.3 tons of CO2e - CNG consumption of 615.52 tons of CO2e - Diesel consumption of 66.12 TN of CO2e - Naphtha consumption of 2.69 tons of CO2e - Outsourced services of 49 tons of CO2e - Employee mobility of 38.3 tons of CO2e
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	The carbon emissions associated with their operations and their contribution to climate change are the potential impacts of their energy intensity.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The company worked with a third party environmental consultants, KOLIBRI, in 2019 to measure their carbon footprint. They then detected actions to be carried out within the offices to improve the use of resources and energy (electricity, water, waste). They then looked to mitigation of the carbon footprint by contributing to the protection of native forests. The company has set objectives and committed to their execution and sustain them over time. They have a five-year commitment with a renewal plan to continue mitigating their emissions. Their goal for 2021 is to expand awareness-raising work with training to significant external providers. The company does not have a comparison with industries that carry out the same activity as their company. In 2020, the company was certified carbon neutral in offsetting their total carbon emissions
	(inclusive of scope 1, 2 and 3) by planting a total of 13.119 m2 of trees in the Atlantic Forest which increases the surface area of the Parque Nacional Urugua-i, combats climate change, helps endangered species and supports local communities.
