SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a distiller, Two Drifters Distillery LTD operates in an industry that is water intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 91% of revenue was earned from the sale of alcohol
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	"As a water intensive industry, distilling poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. Two Drifters Distillery Ltd uses mains water provided by South West Water. Currently, the company's water usage is not large enough to majorly impact other stakeholders that rely on the water provided by South West Water."
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	"The company's consumption in 2019 was 205 m3 and its consumption in 2020 was 365 m3. It is true that as the company continues to grow it will increase its water consumption, given that 60% of the company's 40%ABV (Alcohol by Volume) product is water. Water is also necessary for the fermentation process and, of course, for cleaning the vessels. However, as a distillery the company takes great pride in saving water where it is able to. Specifically, all the company's condensers are cooled by a closed loop ethylene glycol/water mix that the company calculates saves 5.5 m3 per batch of molasses fermented. The distillery has produced over 71 batches since beginning in 2019. This is around 390.5 m3 of water saved since production started. After the fermentation process, the company performs the first distillation. The waste produced from this process contains both water and valuable molasses nutrients. The waste is transported to a local farmer less than 10 miles, or 16 kilometers, away; this means the water is not simply wasted, but used locally. The waste material has to be cooled, though, and the company uses water passed through a heat exchanger to cool this waste. The water that is heated is used for the cleaning of vessels. So, both the water and energy is conserved in this process. Water useage is directly related to CO2 emissions. During its LCA of 2020 the company used 205 m3 and this directly caused 71.74 kgCO2e and therefore has to use the Climeworks removal tool to remove that CO2. CO2 is emitted in the processing and transport networks for water and these are considered direct emissions to the company or Scope 1. As a business, Two Drifters Distillery continues to grow and there will be a need to continuously monitor its water use. The company has a water meter and takes regular updates because the company is focused on its CO2 emissions and the water usage contributes to its Scope 1 emissions. Since the company commits to having a carbon negative footprint through carbon dioxide removal by Climework

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	Two Drifters Distillery is a distiller that earns a material amount of reveue from the sale of alcohol. The company produces rum alcohol from sugar cane molasses with an %ABV of 40% and 60%. The company sells alcohol to wholesale and retail. The company also serves alcohol on its premises.

IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Alcohol may have a negative impact on the health and well-being of individuals and their communities.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	"Two Drifters Distillery has all relevant licences and adheres to best practices encouraged by regulatory authorities in relation to the sale of alcohol in the jurisdictions where it operates. The company has labelling on all of its products that indicates the recommended units of alcohol that the Chief Medical Officer for the UK advises for consumption for both men and women. Additionally, there is a recommendation for pregnant women not to consume alcohol. The company's staff are required to complete their Personal Licence, the training for which includes learning about serving alcohol and the responsibilities associated with serving alcohol. The company employs an Age 25 check policy that states the company actively asks for identification if a customer appears under 25. Additionally, all staff are trained in how to deal with over-serving issues and when to stop serving a customer, if that is appropriate. These policy's are best practices and encouraged by the regulating authorities, they are not law."able to.
