Disclosure Materials

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to a background check by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

| Summary of Issue | <p>Marmoset is a full-service music agency representing vintage & emerging music and creating original scores and compositions for commercial projects/film with a revenue of > 10MM.</p> <p>In the last 5 years, Marmoset had three cases of infringement, of which 2 of these have been closed through settlement with a third party, and 1 dropped by the claimant.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Feb 2017 = MSX II Audio: Alleged copyright infringement claim, - CLOSED• Sep 2017 = Townhouse Music: Media - primary infringement - case was DROPPED by claimant• Dec 2019 = Liquid Liquid: Alleged copyright infringement - SETTLED |

| | <p>Marmoset opted to defend the song/artist even though it wasn't a work-for-hire asset that we owned (it was owned by the artist Jeff Brodsky, and created independently of us), as this felt like a particularly erroneous claim.</p> |
| Management Practices | <p>The company updated its practices/policies to prevent future claims. Marmoset now has a much more formal onboarding process for freelance composers with clear guidelines to help avoid these situations, as well as reminders of the company policies throughout the process of working with them on each project.</p> <p>Additionally, when a client asks them to create music based on a specific reference song (a common practice throughout the industry, and potentially high risk for copyright infringement...) Marmoset does extensive research and provides a number of alternate reference songs and other creative brief materials to their composers to eliminate the risk of creating a "soundalike."</p> <p>Marmoset also works to educate clients about this process and make sure they understand the legal position these kinds of requests can put them in. A couple of times over the last few years, they have declined client projects because they insisted on creative direction that felt like a high risk of copyright infringement.</p> |
