Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

The current B Corp Certification assesses a company's risk (potential negative impacts) separately from its positive impacts. B Lab's risk standards are additional minimum requirements that companies in controversial industries and/or practices must meet in order to be eligible for B Corp Certification under V1.6. Risk standards are a necessary method to maintain credibility, manage risk, and achieve the impact B Lab seeks in the world.

Laboratorios Pharmamerican SRL is directly involved in the Pharmaceutical Industry; an industry which B Lab requires additional minimum standards. During this assessment, it was confirmed that Laboratorios Pharmamerican SRL fully meets the minimum requirements for the Pharmaceutical Industry as outlined in the [Guidance for Eligibility Concerns and Minimum Requirements under V1.6](#) link.

The company does not engage in lobbying or advocacy activities with government agencies, makes no political contributions or donations to political parties or candidates, and is not a member of trade associations with political advocacy activities. Given the company's size and profile, formal policies on revolving doors and specific controls on political contributions have not deemed necessary. The company complies with all applicable regulations regarding transparency and relations with the public sector.

The company publicly discloses its research and development strategy in its Sustainability Report which is available on the [company's website](#). The company focuses on the development and continuous improvement of dietary supplements, herbal medicines, and herbal teas to deliver safe and innovative products. Its R&D activities include the development of new formulations, optimization of existing products, stability studies, process validation, regulatory compliance, and cross-functional collaboration to ensure technical feasibility and alignment with market needs. The company also outlines its intellectual property strategy, explaining that it protects proprietary knowledge through internal confidentiality procedures, secure management of technical documentation, and confidentiality agreements with clients, suppliers, and third parties. In addition, it publicly reports that it allocates human, technical, and financial resources to R&D each year, disclosing that 2% of its 2025 operating expenses were invested in R&D activities, including new product development, reformulation of existing products, stability studies, evaluation of new raw materials, process validation, analytical testing, and technical training of the R&D team.



Since the products are dietary supplements rather than prescription medicines/drugs, pricing which is volume-based and globally consistent is reasonable. The LMIC equitable pricing expectation is aimed at traditional prescription medicines.
