DISCLOSURE QUESTIONNAIRE CATEGORY	Environmentally Intensive Industries
TOPIC	Energy and Emissions Intensive Industries
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a manufacturing company that delivers meal kits to customers, Fresh Prep operates in an industry in which energy and carbon emissions are material environmental issues. Aspects of the industry that make it energy and emissions-intensive include the use of manufacturing machinery and Fresh Prep operations utilize an in-house delivery fleet for all of their meal kits.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company derived 100% of its revenue from meal kits in 2021. The kits are manufactured in company facilities and hand delivered to each customer address by Fresh Prep vans.
	A scope of CO2 emissions for the cycle of summer 2021-summer 2022 evaluating impact of electricity usage, paper consumption, and transportation of goods includes that of the scope 1 and 2 generators evaluated, heating accounted for 11% of company emissions, refrigeration for 5%, transporting of goods for 11%, and electricity usage for 25% of company emissions. Scope 3 generators including garbage, paper consumption, staff commuting, and additional transportation accounted for 47% of company emissions.
	The company's carbon intensity per unit product is currently 0.91kg co2e per meal kit produced.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As an energy-intensive industry, manufacturing poses risks such as energy waste or overuse if resources are not appropriately managed.
	The company uses primarily electricity but also fossil fuels for its fleet. The company has several facilities for packaging and distribution and fleets are based out of each location for deliveries on set schedules with organized and consolidated routes.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	In the company's manufacturing and delivery efforts, contributors to the company's carbon footprint include large scale electrically powered equipment, and emissions from deliveries. Fresh Prep has consolidated delivery routes and also purchases carbon offsets for 100% of their deliveries. They have a Climate Smart certification to establish baseline emissions and set goals for reduction of 5% per unit produced. The company does not currently have data surrounding total carbon emissions but Fresh Prep utilizes reusable packaging including cooler bags for 100% of deliveries, and zero-waste kits in approximately half of deliveries. In comparing themselves to other meal kit companies, Fresh Prep has not found this to be a common practice with market competitors.

TOPIC	Water Intensive Industries
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a manufacturing company, Fresh Prep operates in an industry that is water intensive. Aspects of the industry that make it water intensive include cleaning, sanitizing, and supply sourcing. Fresh Prep uses water for cleaning food and reusable packaging including cooler bags and zero-waste containers.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 100% of Fresh Prep's revenue was earned from the manufacturing and delivery of meal kits.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Manufacturing poses risks such as water pollution and waste if water use is not appropriately managed. Fresh Prep sources materials from suppliers and are not drawing excessive water from sources for kit ingredient. The company is located in broader Vancouver, BC, where water sources are not stressed, and they are not creating excessive water waste as the water they use can be returned to the municipal system and does not require specialty treatment. Long-term water stress is not currently a concern based on current demands and regionally sourced water.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The company has invested significant capital in their reusable product lines; technological patents and the use an advanced sterilization process demand less water and energy resourcing than when the process began. Currently, the company does not track water usage, nor have set reduction targets, but this is planned for adoption and implementation by year's end. Research conducted by Fresh Prep supports that water from grocery store waste and food waste when not proportioned, like in meal kits, is significantly higher than when proportioned. Fresh Prep is aiming to reduce food waste, water waste, and the footprint of food waste, by making meal kits more sustainable through less waste, and increasingly reusable packaging and distribution methods. Their facilities have also installed low flow fixtures, Energy Star Appliances, and irrigation improvements to reduce water usage and waste.
