Environmentally Intensive Industries
Water Intensive Industries
As a vineyard and winery, Avignonesi operates in an industry that is water intensive. Aspects of the industry that make it water intensive include irrigation used in the cultivation of vines, water used in the winemaking process (e.g. for cleaning tanks and barrels), and water used in the bottling process.
The company derived 100% of its revenue from its wine segment in 2020. In 2020, the company consumed an aggregate of 30.5Mio litres of water for a total production of 0.8Mio litres of wine, which makes it about 37 litres of water for one litre of wine. This consumption includes all the company's sites: vineyards, wineries, cellars, bottling, warehouse, agritourism, staff accommodation, offices and olive oil mill. 100% of the wine produced and sold by Avignonesi is made exclusively with grapes cultivated in their vineyards and processed in their cellar. These practices guarantee that all the water required for their wine production is accounted for in the company's footprint.
As water intensive industries, agriculture and wine production poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. Avignonesi buys about one third of its water from the grid, and its wells and lakes supply the rest. The company is located in a low water stress level region, according to Aquastat (2018).
"Avignonesi has an internal monitoring system to record its water usage and avoid wastes from leakages. To manage their water resources needed for the vineyard, they harvest rainwater and only irrigate about 50% of the vineyards, all using drip technolog. They may irrigate some of their vineyards only when the local authorities declare a drought state of emergency. They optimise the quantity of water required for irrigation based on monitoring and analysis of soil moisture level, weather data and other relevant information. Three particular water conservation practices utilized by them are: i) Water stress measurement by using Scholander pressure bombs ii) ETP models according to the data collected from their weather stations iii) Water stress potential maps. The company does an analysis of the water in all its lakes every 2 years. At all the business sites (cellar, bottling, washing sites), the used water is treated appropriately (decanted/filtered with plants/oxygenated) before re-entry into the water table. All the company's wastewater management practices are in line with requirements of the AUA (Univa Environmental Authorization) which is issued by the Tuscany Region, where the company operates.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a vineyard and winery, Avignonesi operates in an industry in which biodiversity impact and monoculture agriculture are material environmental issues.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company derived 100% of its revenue from its wine segment in 2020. The company has 333 hectares of land of which approximately 183 hectares are cultivated (55%). The non cultivated land is used as: buildings/TARE (18%), forest area (13%), polyphytic meadow (13%), set aside from production (0.5%) and vegetable garden (0.14%). Normally, 2.8% of land is actively replanted each year.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Monoculture poses a risk to local ecosystems of flora and fauna as well as the potential degradation of cultivated land.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Avignonesi grows 15 grape varieties in its vineyards. Besides viticulture and olive groves, the company tries to promote a variety of other agricultural activities on their lands, including beekeeping, gardening with crop rotation and animal raising. Since 2018 Avignonesi have been planting trees in available spaces around their lands. Approximately 40 ha of their land consists of forest that they do not interfere with. Avignonesi changed the type of plant used in their crops cover to enhance biodiversity and they promote the flowering of their cover crop to attract a higher variety of insects into the vineyard. The company also uses the technique of sexual confusion for Berry Moths which allows them to reduce the amount of non-specific (organic) insecticide in the vineyards. The company is certified organic and biodynamic claims to do not use pesticides and/or chemical fertilizers.

IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The company complies with all local regulations concering the sale and production of alcohol. To promote responsible consumption, Avignonesi employs a strict no drink and drive policy for all its internal events. The company is a wine producer with only one direct selling point to customers (which is the restaurant and tasting center) where they do not serve minors. Visitors are filtered into adults and children at the point of booking itself. Additionally, all the B2B clients that Avignonesi works with are required to adhere to the company's code of conduct wherein they follow legal requirements of the place in which they operate, as well as manage the social impacts of their activities.
