

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a brewery, Aslan Brewing Company operates in an industry that is water intensive. Aslan Brewing Company is a microbrewery and restaurant in Downtown Bellingham, exclusively brewing 100% USDA Certified Organic beer for the Pacific Northwest.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 59% of Aslan Brewing Company's revenue was earned from the sale of alcohol. The company uses 5.9 pints of water to make 1 pint of beer.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water-intensive industry, brewing poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. The company's water source is their local watershed. The company is not in a water-stressed region.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The company offset 50% of their water usage through water restoration certificates purchased through the Bonneville Environmental Foundation. The company's target is to continue offsetting at least 50 % of their water usage. The company does not conduct an assessment of how it compares with others in their industry in terms of water usage and/or management.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	Aslan Brewing Company is a brewery that earns a material amount of revenue from the sale of alcohol. Aslan Brewing Company is a microbrewery and restaurant in Downtown Bellingham, exclusively brewing 100% USDA Certified Organic beer for the Pacific Northwest.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 59% of Aslan Brewing Company's revenue was earned from the sale of alcohol.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Alcohol may have a negative impact on the health and well-being of individuals and their communities.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The Company has a formal statement in its Employee Handbook in section 8 ""Age limitations and Certifications for Serving Alcohol: 1. Individuals must be at least 18 years of age to deliver alcohol, and at least 21 years of age to pour alcohol or work in the brewery. 2. Employees must have a current MAST permit to serve or pour alcohol. If you are touching alcohol to serve the public, you must have a MAST permit. Washington state law requires you to have your MAST permit within 60 days of hire The company complies with all of the regulations and laws related to the sale of alcohol in the jurisdictions where you operate. The company also outlines responsible service guidelines in their employee handbook, in regards to age and over-consumption. They have a policy to never encourage customers to over-consume on their social channels.
