Summary of Issue	Lacerda Diniz Sena Advogados has had two litigation cases related to labor contracts and overtime hours over the last 5 years.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	First case: Case closed. Lacerda Diniz Sena Advogados lost it and had to pay the other party the equivalent of <1% of revenue. Second case: Pending with a remote possibility of Lacerda Diniz Sena Advogados to lose.

Resolution	Lacerda Diniz Sena Advogados lost the first case and had to pay the other party. The second case is pending.
Management Practices	After the first case, the actions taken to avoid issues in the future were: • Improvement on partnership contracts; • Changes in the management culture: Implement a program called "Program of Management in Sight" to monitor the office results and be transparent regarding profit sharing.

Summary of Issue	Lacerda Diniz Sena Advogados has clients in the following industries: Mining, Fossil Fuel, and Defense.
	The types of services/products offered to these clients include: • Legal services
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the last fiscal year, 1.07% of the company's annual revenue was from clients in mining, 0.07% from defense and 1.49% from fossil fuels.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can directly or indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
	Companies offering certain types of services and products to controversial clients are required to have at minimum a grievance/complaints mechanism and a whistleblower protection policy.
Implemented Management Practices	Lacerda Diniz Sena Advogados has the following mechanisms in place to manage the risks related to its business relationships with clients in controversial and ineligible industries:
	Grievance/complaints mechanism. This is accessible to employees, business partners, and society in general through email (integridade@lacerdadinizsena.com.br). The company also has a webpage with details about how to share a grievance with them, the circumstances that will be investigated, and other details. After receiving a complaint, the Ethics Committee has a period of 30 (thirty) days to investigate and adopt the measures it deems appropriate and necessary.
