Topic	Cultivation of Tobacco
Summary of Issue	N&B is a cosmetic product manufacturer based in Italy. The company has a product that includes Tobacco extract made in the company's cosmetic laboratory using Organic Certified Tobacco cultivated by the company. N&B does not use or sell Tobacco for non-cosmetic purposes nor purchases tobacco from third parties.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the last fiscal year 2% of the total number of the company's products and 3.5% of their revenue was derived from the sale of products containing Tobacco extract.
Impact on Stakeholders	B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with the Tobacco industry as a material issue and may create new standards to address possible risks related to this matter. The intended scope for this industry can be all nicotine products, including e-cigarettes, vaping devices, and heat-not-burn technologies. N&B Srl Società Benefit cultivates organic tobacco to apply its extract on some cosmetic products. Although there are research papers to show the potential benefits of using tobacco extract in cosmetic products, B Lab does not have an established standard of best practices to prevent the potentially negative health impacts of tobacco use in the cosmetic
	industry. Whenever risk standards for companies involved with tobacco are available, N&B Srl Società Benefit will have one grace period of one recertification cycle to comply with the new guidance.
Implemented Management Practices	N&B adheres to the European Union regulations regarding the ingredients they use in their products and ensure the safety of their products. All cosmetic products are regulated under Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 which sets out requirements for safety, labeling and marketing of cosmetic products.



	With regards to Tobacco cultivation, the extract the company uses is organic and the quantity they cultivate/produce is under
	the limit stated by the EU and the N&B does not require permission to produce.
	The company uses the leaves of the tobacco plant and produces natural compost, reused in other agricultural processes.

Management comments	N&B cultivates organic, spontaneous tobacco plants in Salento, a region where tobacco has been traditionally significant for the local economy. The tobacco seeds, dormant in the soil, were naturally activated thanks to regenerative farming practices and the high polysaccharide content in aloe vera, and came out alone without any input. This sustainable farming method aligns with regenerative and circular economy principles, as the entire process—from plant growth to the creation of compost from waste—ensures a positive environmental impact. The tobacco leaves are harvested and used in N&B's laboratories to create a powerful organic extract, which has
	impressed everyone by demonstrating significant functions when used as an active ingredient in cosmetics. This extract, rich in polysaccharides, flavonoids, and peptides, serves as a



powerful antioxidant. It enhances the effectiveness of other active ingredients in the skincare products, contributing to moisturizing, anti-aging, anti-wrinkle, and skin-rebalancing activities. The final products combine this tobacco extract with other organic ingredients like Aloe Vera, Olive Oil, and Pomegranate, promoting the skin's natural repair and protection processes. N&B's approach represents a harmonious blend of tradition and innovation, leveraging the natural benefits of tobacco for modern skincare.
