Disclosure Materials

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to a background check by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

B Lab's Public Complaints Process

Any party may submit a complaint about a current B Corp through B Lab's Public Complaint Process. Grounds for complaint include:

- 1) Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process
- Breaches of the B Corp Community's core values as expressed in our Declaration of Interdependence

| Management Comments | In accordance with internal guidelines, Evergreen GmbH is allowed to buy stocks of companies belonging to the industries 'Mining' and 'Pharmaceuticals'. The amount of shares varies regularly, with each rebalancing, but always remains at a low level. |
| | Evergreen GmbH is convinced that there must be companies that develop and sell pharmaceutical products, as well as companies that extract raw materials for building. |
| | However, the selected companies, just like all other companies in the Evergreen investment universe, undergo the strict Evergreen sustainability process. This process includes exclusion and positive criteria as well as regular controversy monitoring and an interdisciplinary sustainability committee. This ensures that the selected companies in the two controversial industries are pioneers in their respective sectors on an ecological and/or social level." |
