Environmentally Intensive Industries
Energy and Emissions Intensive
As a food manufacturer, Euro Frits operates in an industry in which energy and carbon emissions is a material environmental issue.
100% of the company's revenue is derived from food manufacturing.
The food manufacturing industry is a major contributor to global carbon emissions. The energy and emission intensive aspect of the company's operation is related to frozen food manufacturing processes. The Euro Frits' energy sources include natural gas and electrical energy from renewable wind and water sources and soon, from solar energy sources.
Euro Frits has audited its consumption and emissions and set the following specific reduction targets for 2023: • Electricity consumption (KW/tn) \rightarrow < 0.55 in 2023. (\neg 6.5%) • Natural gas consumption (KW/tn) \rightarrow < 0.54 in 2023. (\neg 3.0%) • Fuel consumption (litres/tn) \rightarrow 2,350 in 2023. (\neg 3.0%) • Non-hazardous waste (tn/tn) \rightarrow < 0.094 in 2023. (\neg 3.0%) • Treatment and effluents (m3/tn) \rightarrow < 4.95 in 2023. (\neg 3.0%) • GHG emissions, scope 1(CO2/tn) \rightarrow < 0.143 in 2023. (\neg 3.0%) During the last year, Euro Frits has installed 1,350 solar panels, which will avoid the emission of a total of 8,900 tonnes of CO2 into the atmosphere annually. The company does not currently measure the energy intensity of the company or the carbon intensity per unit of product.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a food manufacturing company, Euro Frits operates in an industry that is water intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 100% of the company's revenue was earned from the sale of water intensive food products.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water intensive industry, food manufacturing poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. Eurofrits obtains its water from the public water network in Burgos, Spain, where the company operates. This area is not considered a water-stressed region according to the Spanish State Meteorological Agency. According to the evaluation of the water balance, soil moisture reaches 80% and evotranspiration is 0mm. Burgos is classified as normal according to the Standardized Precipitation Index.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Eurofrits' monitors its water consumption and as has calculated its water intensity. During 2021, 13,732 tonnes were produced and 109,525 m3 of water were used. For kg of product produced, 7.97 litres of water were used. The company has not set specific reduction targets and has not yet compared itself with others in the industry.
