Topic	Energy and Emissions Intensive Industries
Summary of Issue	As a home constructor/developer, Trico Homes operates in an industry that is energy and emissions intensive.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of their revenue comes from their activities as homebuilders.
Impact on Stakeholders	Energy intensive manufacturing activities, pose an environmental risk due to the emissions produced by such energy use. The extent of environmental impact is dependent on the energy sources utilised and management practices in place to manage energy use. Trico Homes uses Calgary's energy grid, which is comprised of fossil fuels, natural gas, biodiesel, solar and wind power. It's worth noting that Alberta is a leader in Canada for wind energy production.
Implemented Management Practices	Trico Homes is committed to climate resilience in their operations and are currently focused on planning & building their first net-zero home;
	In addition, Trico Homes aims to reduce their carbon footprint beyond regulatory levels and sourcing environmentally friendly materials.
	Trico Homes is continuously benchmarking themselves against competitors and the rest of the industry and plan to include energy usage and carbon emissions in their benchmarking process in the future.
	Trico's vehicle fleet is currently outfitted with a Vehicle GPS/Monitoring & Telematics Device that reports & provides feedback on all vehicle usage – Idling, driving, speed etc. Trico has also achieved a significant milestone of a 25% reduction of usage of heaters in homes through the construction process. Trico has also endeavored to transition their current vehicle fleet to electric, however availability is currently constrained.

Topic	Water Intensive Industries
Summary of Issue	As a home constructor/developer, Trico Homes operates in an industry that is water intensive. Water is primarily used in concrete work, like foundations, driveways, sidewalks & stairs of their projects.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of their revenue comes from their activities as homebuilders.
Impact on Stakeholders	As a water intensive industry, the home construction industry poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed.
	The company uses water from the Elbow River Watershed, it's the source for approximately 40% of Calgary's water supply. The other 60% is supplied by the Bow River Watershed.
Implemented Management Practices	Trico Homes is continuously benchmarking themselves against competitors and the rest of the industry and is always looking at ways to improve. To date, water usage &/or management has not been included in their benchmarking reports but may in the future.
	Trico will be working through targets with their builder group this upcoming year.
	Trico uses only low-flow toilets, along with high-efficiency tankless water heaters within their newly built homes. Typically underground sprinkler systems are not installed by Trico, they are usually installed by the customer after purchase.
	Trico will adhere to all City of Calgary Water Restrictions https://www.calgary.ca/water/programs/drought.html
	Currently at head office they water in the early morning hours for the minimal possible time allotted, no more than 4 hours a week using their underground irrigation system on a timer. - Watering of lawns, gardens & shrubs - Limited to 1 day per week - Watering of new (unestablished) lawns - Permitted for new sod
	(within 21 days)
