

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

TOPIC	Water Intensive Industries
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a beverage manufacturer, Kiro operates in an industry that is water intensive. Water is not only a key ingredient in the final product but also required for cleaning the manufacturing equipment.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 100% of Kiro's revenue was earned from the sale of beverages.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	"Industries that are water intensive risk impacting their local water tables and disproportionately consume water at a rate that contributes to the depletion of local water sources over time if not appropriately managed. Affected stakeholders may therefore include local agriculture, local ecosystems, and communities in water-scarce or water insecure areas."
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Kiro's factory is supplied by SAAE (the service concessionaire in the city of Atibaia). Kiro has recently invested in new equipment (tank and filling system) and technologies for optimising water resources. With this, the company has reduced its water consumption by 10 times for carrying out the CIP (Cleaning in Place). Kiro currently has a ratio of 6 liters of water for the final production of 1 liter of its beverages and with increasing scale it will have efficiency gains as the volume of water used in sanitisation will remain the same regardless of batch size. An average of 3 to 4 liters of water to produce 1 liter of beverage iserves as a goal for Kiro. Water is reused for general factory washing (floors and surfaces). The factory is subject to careful inspections to assess the treatment of effluents and solid waste management. Kiro has always been in compliance with the regulatory agenda.
