Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Animal Testing

Topic	Company tests its pet products on animals before their official launch
Summary of Issue	Just for Pets is a pet products company based in France. The company tests its products on animals before their official launch to ensure the relevance and appeal of their offerings. These in vivo tests are conducted to assess the interest in bowls and toys, as well as the palatability and chewing duration of consumables. This kind of testing is not legally required by any local or national regulation.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company releases approximately 35 new products per calendar year and all products are tested. These make up 100% of annual revenue.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	Animal testing and experimentation is widely used to develop new products and to test their safety. Many of these experiments can cause pain or discomfort to the animals involved, or reduce their quality of life in other ways.
Implemented Management Practices	Just For Pets has its own internal animal welfare policy to apply in the context of its product testing. The company excludes any form of invasive or constraining testing. The tests carried out are limited to natural observations of feeding behavior, in a safe and familiar domestic environment for the animal. All tests are short-term, no deprivation of food, water, or activity is practiced and each response is recorded in the form of a free behavioral observation or a simple response form, with no rating imposed on the animal or restrictive protocol. Palatability tests are conducted occasionally, only during the development of new products or in the case of a significant change in formulation. These tests are never systematic and are solely intended to ensure the product's acceptability and satisfaction by the animal, after laboratory safety tests have validated the product's safety. Over the past three years, no negative impact on the health or well-being of the animals that participated in the tests has been reported. All tested products had previously passed laboratory food safety tests, ensuring the absence of toxicity. All feedback



received from families and dog owners who participated in the tests has been positive. The testing process is supervised by a certified canine behaviorist and follows positive reinforcement methods to ensure the animals' well-being.

The company does not use any breeding facilities, laboratories, shelters, or dedicated testing facilities. No test is conducted without the clear, informed, and written consent of the animal's owner(s). The company relies on its family dogs, those of its brand ambassadors, as well as dogs belonging to its customers who volunteer to participate. The company's co-founder, former president of an animal protection association and certified canine behaviorist, personally ensures compliance with animal welfare conditions.
