Topic	Fishing, Fisheries, and Aquaculture Industry
Summary of Issue	Bendito Mar is a cooperative focused on sustainable aquaculture. They specialize in harvesting and cultivating high-quality bivalve mollusks (shellfish). Their work combines various professional and scientific skills to promote regenerative practices that aim to restore marine ecosystems while producing seafood.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	<p>100% of the company's revenue is generated through the sales of clams and oysters.</p> <p>18% of the company's seafood were from third-party suppliers, while the remaining 82% came from the company's direct cultivation. 100% of the company's cultivation activities, directly and through suppliers, are traceable.</p>
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	The fishing industry may have negative environmental impacts on their affected marine ecosystems, e.g., overfishing, loss of biodiversity, pollution. Furthermore, the fishing industry is at risk of human rights violations in their supply chains.
Implemented Management Practices	<p>The company operates a farming-based aquaculture model, producing oysters and clams through controlled cultivation rather than wild capture. This reduces exposure to overfishing and biodiversity depletion risks typically associated with extractive fishing practices.</p> <p>The majority of production is internally farmed. A limited portion of volume is sourced from third-party farms, all of which are locally based and legally permitted. The company conducts on-site field visits to third-party farms to verify the existence of valid operating permits, thereby mitigating risks associated with illegal or unregulated production.</p> <p>The company operates in compliance with all applicable Mexican aquaculture and food safety regulations, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Aquaculture concessions and registration with the national fisheries authority (CONAPESCA);- Health and biosecurity programs supervised by SENASICA;

- Ongoing water quality monitoring for harvest area classification;
- Sanitary controls for handling and commercialization overseen by [COFEPRIS](#).

Operations are governed by an internal Good Aquaculture Practices Manual, which functions as a preventive control framework to identify, mitigate, and avoid environmental, health, social, and operational risks.

While the company does not currently hold international third-party sustainability certifications, the management has expressed a documented intention to pursue such certifications in the medium term as part of a continuous improvement strategy.

The company maintains full traceability across its production, supported by daily operational logs that track batches from seed to harvest. Each product delivery includes a traceability ticket containing farm certification details, lot numbers, harvest dates and locations, product type, quantities, and customer information.

Operational, harvest, mortality, and biosecurity records are retained indefinitely in both physical and digital formats for verification and audit purposes.

Supplier selection is based on legal compliance, crop health, and product quality. Environmental and social risks within the supply chain are managed through:

- Direct sourcing from known, local suppliers;
- Regular on-site visits (at least biannually);
- Ongoing communication and internal oversight by operations and sustainability management.

The company relies on direct employment, which reduces reliance on labor intermediaries and associated risks. Employment practices are aligned with national labor legislation. Where legally permitted, minors may be engaged only under strict conditions, including parental consent, non-hazardous work, and dignified working conditions. Working conditions, health, and safety are monitored through:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Direct field supervision;- Clearly defined roles and work schedules;- Mandatory use of personal protective equipment;- Ongoing operational records and internal meetings. <p>Workplace incidents or grievances are addressed through direct communication channels with supervisors or management, with documented follow-up and corrective actions where necessary.</p>
