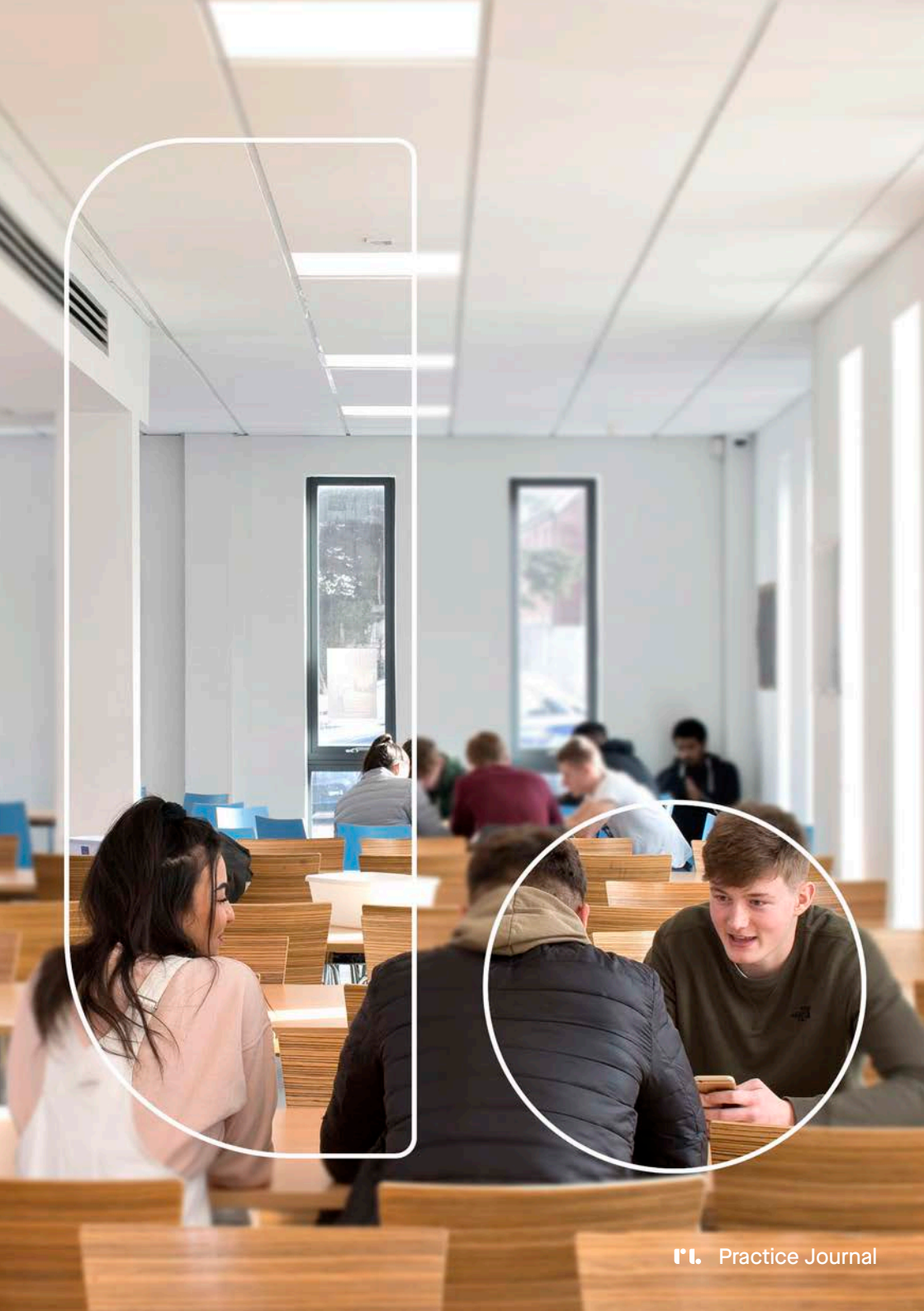

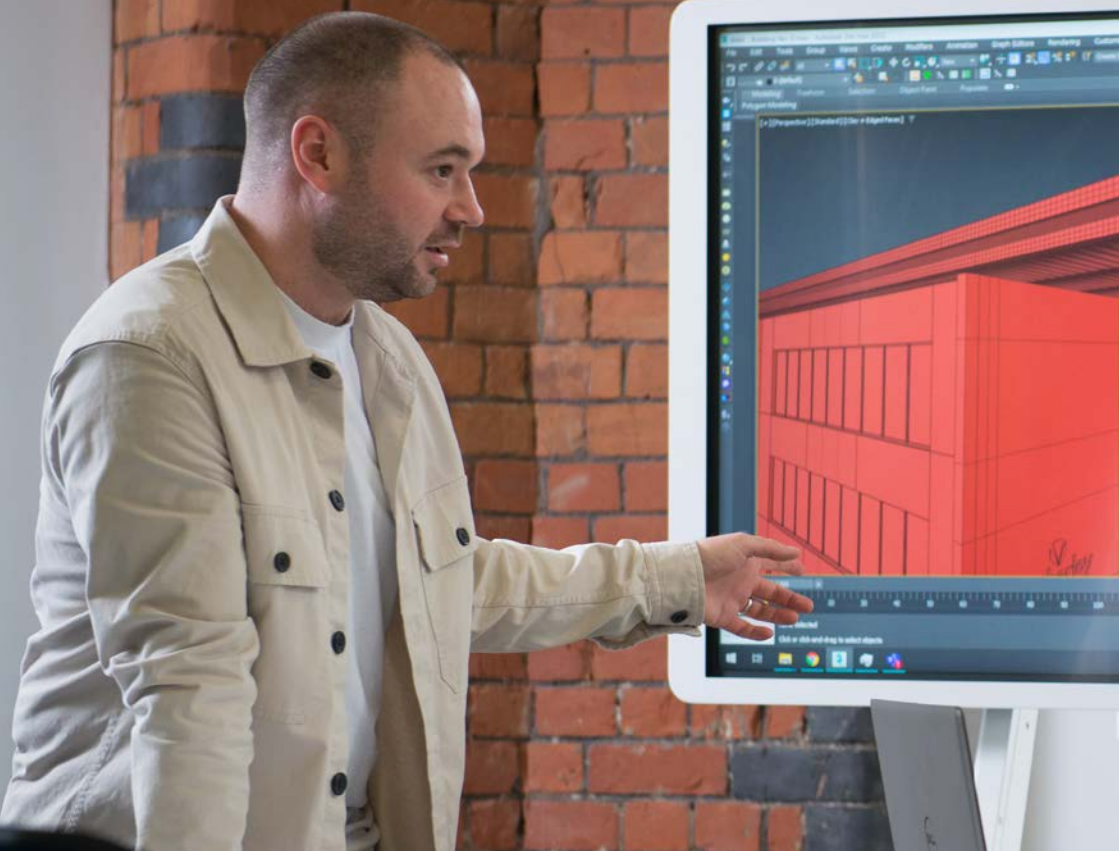

Creative and collaborative

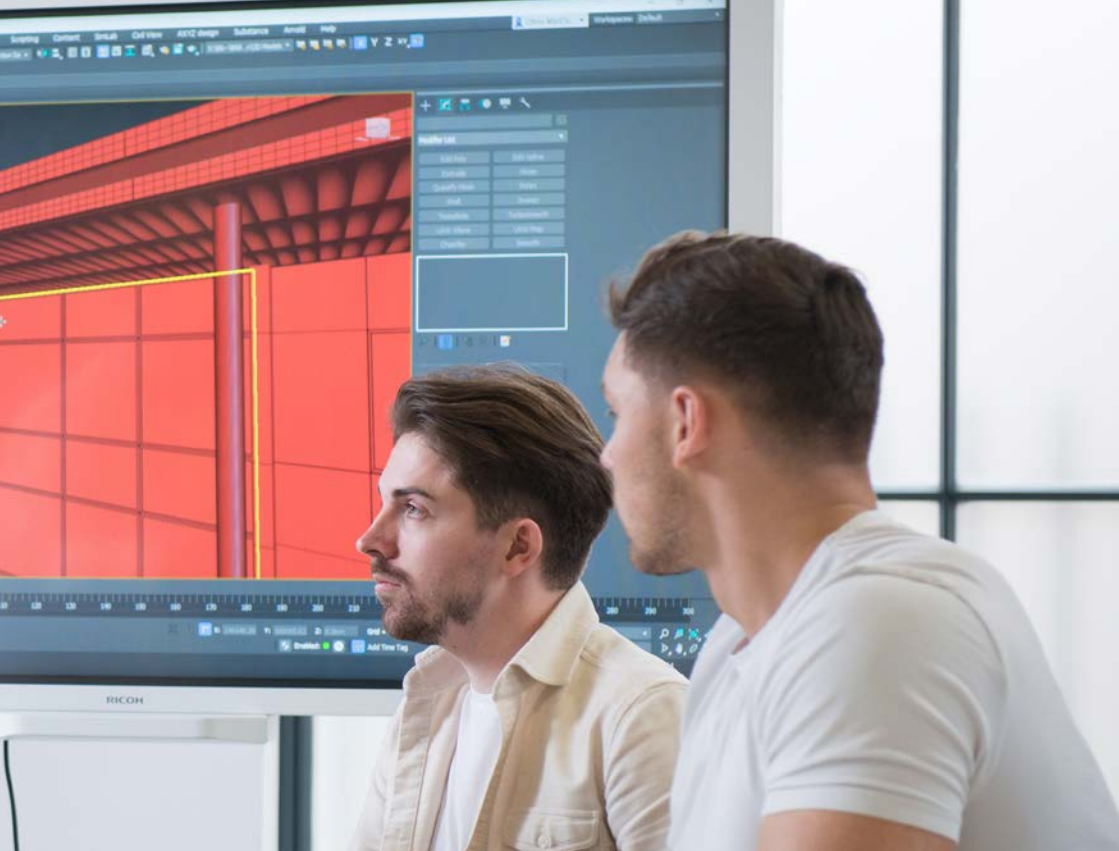

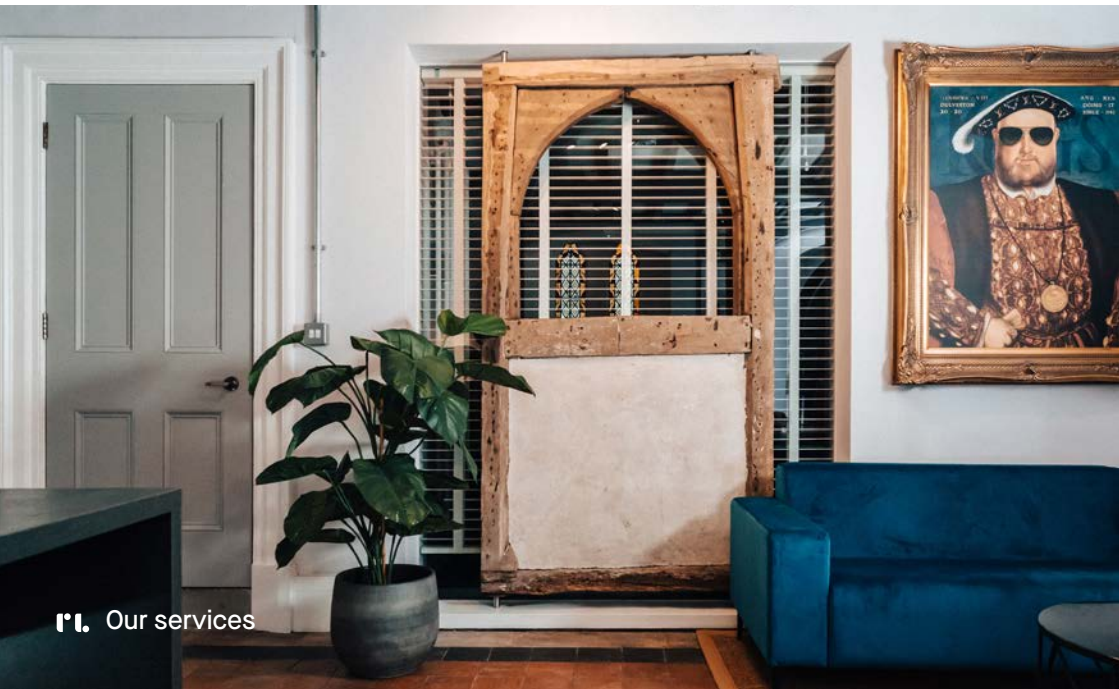
