| Summary of Issue | Ladera Sur is a media outlet focused on topics related to science & biodiversity, nature, the outdoors, travel and the environment. |
| | The company has provided advertorial services to clients in the pharmaceutical industry which is deemed controversial by B Lab. The advertorial helps the public dispose unused or expired remedies, helping the environment and avoiding mishandling of remedies. |
| | All of the company's services can be sold to both controversial as well as non-controversial industries, although it is tailored from client/industry to client/industry. |
| Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected) | 0.72% of the company's revenue has been from clients in the pharmaceutical industry. The company charges a flat-rate for all of its clients regardless of the industry, depending on the type of service requested. The company has only served clients in the pharmaceutical industry for the year of 2024. |
| Impact on Stakeholders | Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. |
| | B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter. |
