Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Business in Conflict Zones

Topic	Origin Coffee Holdings Limited sources coffee beans from Ethiopia and Myanmar.
Summary of Issue	The company is a coffee roaster based in the UK. Origin Coffee Holdings Limited purchased ground coffee beans indirectly from Ethiopia's underserved farmers through an exporter, Sucafina and Myanmar's farmers through an importer, IndoChina. The countries are listed as a conflict zone in World Bank's FY23 List of Fragile and Conflict-affected Situations .
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Purchases coming from Ethiopia and Myanmar represented 6.4% of the company purchases in 2022.
Impact on Stakeholders	As per the OECD, conflict zones are often characterized by widespread human rights abuses and violations of national or international law. High-risk supply chains, such as coffee, have a history of forced and child labor, which subjects workers to poor working conditions, low wages, and puts children at risk for human trafficking.
Implemented Management Practices	In Ethiopia, their partner, Sucafina operates a responsible sourcing programme called IMPACT. The IMPACT program includes a sustainability standard that guarantees compliance with environmental, social, and economic best practices, while also driving measurable, positive change in five key areas of sustainability. The IMPACT Sustainability Standard – co-designed by Sucafina and a consultancy partner, Peterson and Control Union, in consultation with stakeholders – ensures compliance with a set of social, environmental and economic standards. IMPACT is based on the Coffee Sustainability Reference Code (Coffee SR Code) and has been recognized by the Global Coffee Platform as Coffee SR Code equivalent. In Myanmar, USAID introduced Value Chains for Rural Development (VCRD) programme. It supported the development of institutions to facilitate the creation of business norms, the exchange of technical information and the financing necessary to increase capacity.
