IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Daylesford Organic Ltd is fully compliant with all regulations and laws relating to both the sale and consumption of alcohol in the jurisdictions in which it operates.
	All employees who sell or serve alcohol undertake mandatory age related training which includes the sale of alcohol and other potentially hazardous materials. All store managers are required to hold a valid personal alcohol licence and all premises are licensed by their local council(s) for the sale of alcohol.
	The company manages risks related to the sale and consumption of alcohol through regular training and spot checks by management. Over-serving is mitigated through strict use of measures and a ban on free-pouring. Serving/selling to minors is managed through the Challenge 25 policy, with all of the company's staff given confidence to ask for proof of age if customers appear underage.

alls due to undeclared ingredients. Desford Organic Ltd has had two recalls in the last five years due to undeclared ingredients/ gens on the product labeling.
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gene on the product abouty.
February 2020, undeclared egg and hazelnut in biscotti, detected by supplier. March 2020, undeclared almonds in loose bakery (croissants), detected by shop staff.
total amount of revenue represented by the two recalls was <0.2% of the company's annual nue.
affected products did carry a potential risk of consumer illness or injury, due to the nature of agredients that could pose an allergy risk. However, no issues were reported by consumers no classifications from regulators.
esford alerted customers through a public recall and offered a full refund.
company has taken the following actions: Conducted thorough investigations with their suppliers to review the process, identify root causes and introduce measures to prevent reoccurrence. Clear action plans were implemented in each case, working with the suppliers to ensure improved quality control, labelling and allergen notices.
company had two other non-material recalls within the past five years: October 2018, Raw Chocolate Goji Berries – possible metal contamination, detected by the supplier.
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
