- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process

Topic	Company provides tax-related advisory services to clients
Summary of Issue	Switchfoot provides accountancy support and business planning for entrepreneurs and small-businesses.
	The company works with less than 40 United Kingdom (UK) based limited companies and their directors & shareholders. In regards to the company's tax -related services, the company has two director shareholder businesses. One client is part of a simple group structure. The clients are VAT registered and Switchfoot drafts the VAT return for these clients. The company also prepares Personal and corporation Tax returns for UK based individuals. Switchfront occasionally supports R&D claims on the corporation Tax returns based on R&D reports prepared by specialists. Other tax related-services are part of the company's broader services such as financial plannings and pension savings.
	The company does not offer any tax-related services to individuals/businesses outside of the UK, does not advise clients with any connections to Tax havens and does not serve Politically Exposed Persons (PEPs) clients.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Tax advisory services account for 2% of company revenue.
Impact on Stakeholders	Businesses have an obligation to contribute its share of taxes. This is because business exists within the context of society; its proper role is to serve society, not the other way around. Moreover, healthy businesses can only exist over the long term in a healthy society. A healthy society depends upon public expenditures made possible by taxes. These public expenditures benefit business in both direct and indirect ways. B Lab recognizes fair payment of taxes as a material business issue and has a Framework for Evaluating Tax Strategies for B Corp Certification.



Implemented Management Practices

Switchfoot's services are consistent with the principles that, (1) the amount of overall taxes paid over time appropriately reflects the actual amount of income generated by the client, and (2) the amount of taxes paid over time in each jurisdiction appropriately reflects the actual operations of the client in that jurisdiction.

Switchfoot has a Tax Policy which states that;

- "A business should:
 - Pay the right amount of tax (but no more) in the right place at the right time, according to both the letter and the spirit of the law;
 - readily provide sufficient public information to enable its stakeholders to form a rounded and informed view of its beneficial ownership, tax conduct and financial presence (across the world if they are a multinational);
 - say what they pay with pride.

As a business we actively encourage clients to be transparent about their profits and tax practices. We encourage clients to join the Fair Tax foundation. We discourage the use of micro accounts."

In terms of client due-diligence, all of Switchfoot's potential clients are subject to Anti money laundering checks. Switchfoot is regulated by the <u>Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW)</u> and is subject to file checks by the ICAEW. Other relevant google and digital checks are carried out for all clients. All clients are subject to discovery calls and Know you client & risk assessments are carried out. As a small practice, Switchfoot avoids risky assignments and risky industries.
