This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a construction/real estate development company, Assemble operates in an energy intensive industry.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company develops apartment buildings and then manages them. The company has estimated its carbon emissions as 116 tCO2-e for the last fiscal year. These emissions have now been offset.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	The company's carbon emissions associated with their operations and their contribution to climate change along with air pollution and associated health impacts of air quality are the potential impacts of their energy intensity.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The buildings that Asemble develops are gas free and powered by wind power, making them net zero carbon. The company's electricity is sourced from Hepburn Energy. The company is also certified by Climate Action as carbon neutral for its Australian business operations in 2020-2021

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	The company develops apartment buildings and then manages them. As a construction/real estate development company, Assemble operates in a water-intensive industry.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company currently measures its operational water intensity/usage as part of its Climate Active Certification. 100% of the company revenue comes from construction and real estate activities.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water-intensive industry, construction poses risks such as water stress/waste if the water use is not appropriately managed. The company is not located in a water-stressed area.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Assemble uses water-efficiency methods including the following: - Water tanks on all sites to harvest rainwater for reuse in the site's gardens, - Uses appliances and fixtures that have a minimum 5-star ""WELS"" (Water Efficiency Labelling and Standards) rating.
	The company's construction partners are required to have an Environmental Management Plan which encompasses processes like stormwater management, and wastewater management (including reduction, reuse, recycling, and proper disposal of contaminated water).
	Assemble also has a formal Stakeholder Management Plan, which helps the company to identify and classify its project stakeholders; determine stakeholder impact, interest, influence, and trust; and analyze the management approach and communication methodology for each stakeholder."
