Disclosure Materials

Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

B Lab's Public Complaints Process

Any party may submit a complaint about a current B Corp through B Lab's Public Complaint Process. Grounds for complaint include:

- 1) Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process
- Breaches of the B Corp Community's core values as expressed in our Declaration of Interdependence

Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Other - Disclosure Industries

Orión is directly involved in the Artificial Intelligence Industry, which is subject to stakeholders' criticism due to potential risks related to ESG aspects. Currently, B Lab does not have specific requirements for this industry; however, Certified B Corps are required to make transparent their involvement in such industry.

B Lab rationale for moving forward with certification:

• The company began their verification process prior to B Lab, identifying the Artificial Intelligence Industry as an industry that may require further risk review.

As B Lab continues to evolve its standards and due diligence approach for this specific industry, the updated criteria will be shared with the company once they are finalized. The company will then be required to meet these new standards by their next recertification.
