TOPIC	Water Intensive Industries
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a Hotel, the company is in the Service with Significant Environmental Footprint sector and operates in an industry that is water intensive. Aspects of the industry that make it water intensive include cleaning of the facility and water supply for guests rooms for the consumption of drinking and the use of washroom/bathroom.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Inhabit Hotels has not determined specific water intensity as the consumption is based on the occupancy of the guest rooms at their facility.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water intensive industry, the accomodation industry poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. Inhabit Hotel's main water supply comes from Thames Water who source 70% of the water from rivers in the region and 30% from aquifer. As most of the water supply comes from rivers, the environmental and navigational needs of other stakeholder are impacted. Thames water monopolises water supply in the region so there are no other viable alternatives. Inhabit Hotel's operations are not located in a water stressed region.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Inhabit Hotel has limited the facilties' bathtub to 5 nos and the balance 83 rooms are fitted with showers.  The taps installed are with 6 litres per minute water flow restrictors and showers have a 9 litres per minute.  Each floor in the hotel facility is fitted with filtered water stations to cater to guest drinking water requirement as when they require. No additional plastic bottled water is placed in the guest rooms. Water softeners are installed to soften the water and reduce consumption.  Routine maintenance check is carried out by Maintenance team to detect leaks in the flow. Inhabit Hotel works with Con-Serve to monitor the consumption of water in terms of room occupancy. Con-Serve conduct assessment of hotel's usage and provide them with the benchmark report in comparison with the typical and good practice in the region.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a Hotel, the company is in the Service with Significant Environmental Footprint sector and , company operates in an industry that is energy intensive. Aspects of the industry that make it energy intensive mainly includes water boilers and electricity for the room heating and cooling.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Company does not track energy intensity or carbon intensity per unit.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Industries with energy and emission intensive productions can contribute to GHG production which contributes to environmental harm.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	For the use use of gas, Inhabit Hotel uses 100% green gas. For electricity, Inhabit Hotel uses 3% Coal, 39% natural gas, 5% Nuclear, 50% Renewable & 3 % other source of electricity supplied by their local electricity supplier.  The hotel facility has an energy control key card system which controls the usage of electricity in the rooms. They have also LED bulbs installed in all the guest rooms and public spaces, sensor lights installed in the external area of the building. Facility has limited number of power switches and limited number of guest amenities are placed in the rooms. Inhabit Hotel works with Con-Serve to monitor their consumption of energy in terms of room occupancy. Con-Serve conducts assessment on their usage and provide them with the benchmark report in comparison with the typical and good practice in UK
