Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

Topic	Clients in Controversial Industries
Summary of Issue	The company has been serving clients in the Pharmaceuticals industry by offering leadership development programs. Their services can also be sold to both controversial as well as non-controversial industries.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The revenue from clients in the Pharmaceuticals industry represented 8% in FY22-23.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
Implemented Management Practices	The company does not have a screening policy for new client prospects and does not require their clients to sign a code of conduct as their clients already have such standards that the company is expected to sign. The company does have a code of conduct for suppliers and decides about each engagement on a case by case basis. The company will work with clients in select controversial industries as they see an opportunity to make a positive impact through their work by teaching ethical and regenerative leadership practices.

Management Comments	Leadership is a universal skill needed by leaders in all industries. If anything, leaders operating in controversial industries have even more of a responsibility towards the impact of their actions and decisions. Issue Date	2021
Topic	Penalty related to Value-added tax (VAT) classification
Summary of Issue	Over the last 5 years GAIA Insights has had 1 penalty issued by the Steuerverwaltung Basel-Stadt (Swiss Tax authority) that re-assessed the company's VAT classification from "educational services" to "consulting services", resulting in retroactive VAT charges going back as far as 2016.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	GAIA Insights paid a fine that represented 49% of the company revenue during the reported period.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	In addition to the many different aspects of value that businesses provide to society, businesses have an obligation to contribute their share of taxes. As businesses exist within the context of society; their proper role is to serve society. Moreover, healthy businesses can only exist over the long term in a healthy society that depends upon public expenditures made possible by taxes. These public expenditures benefit business in both direct and indirect ways.
Resolution	The company's VAT category was reclassified from "educational services" to "consulting services".
Implemented Management Practices	GAIA Insights collaborated with its accounting provider and the Swiss Tax authorities to fully resolve the issue and apply the new VAT category.
