Disclosure Materials

- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process

| Summary of Issue | Conscious Coffees sources green coffee beans from tier 1 suppliers in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), Ethiopia, Rwanda, Mexico, and Colombia. Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Ethiopia are listed as conflict zones in the FY25 List of Fragile and Conflict-affected Situations and Global Conflict Tracker. |
| Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected) | In the last fiscal year, 20.5% of the company's purchases came from Ethiopia and 1% from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). |
| Impact on Stakeholders | Business activities located in conflict zones are considered high-risk as they are more likely to cause or contribute to the conflict and/or sociopolitical instability. |
| | Countries classified as conflict zones are more likely to have a weak rule of law or a corrupt judicial system, which could undermine the effectiveness of operational grievance mechanisms for these businesses and their suppliers. In addition, the safety of the company's workers and other potential human rights violations are at risk. |
| Implemented Management Practices | All coffee beans sourced by the company are certified Fair Trade. The company maintains a strong commitment to safeguarding the well-being of its employees and partners, and therefore does not operate in conflict zones where there is a credible threat of violence. In circumstances where travel to such regions becomes essential, the company implements strict safety protocols, including group travel arrangements, to mitigate potential risks. In addition to paying above Fair Trade prices for coffee, the company contributes to the Farmer Cooperatives Impact Fund, an initiative established by Cooperative Coffees and financed by participating roasters. This fund provides financial resources to farmer cooperatives for projects with measurable social and environmental impact. Funding proposals are submitted by cooperatives and evaluated by a committee comprising roaster representatives to ensure transparency and accountability. |



For every pound of coffee purchased, the company allocates USD 0.03 to the fund. These contributions are directed toward projects in all sourcing regions, supporting sustainable agricultural practices, community development, and environmental stewardship.
