TOPIC	The company's facilities are located in Guerrero, Mexico.
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	Playa Viva LLC is a Regenerative Luxury Boutique Hotel and Yoga Retreat Center, located in Mexico. More specifically, the company is located in the state of Guerrero, which is listed in the Global Conflict Tracker,
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of the company's revenue comes from its main service Eco Lodge which is based in Guerrero State.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	"Conflict zones are often characterized by widespread human rights abuses and violations of national or international law. Guerrero is flagged for high criminal violence such as homicides, kidnappings, carjackings, and robberies. The security of company workers who work in such areas could also be at risk"
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	 As one of the company's mechanisms to avoid conflict is not to hire people who are linked to these illicit organizations in the region. Playa Viva does not hire anyone who is known to be associated with or part of any illicit organizations. Playa Viva LLC has projects designed for the local community, related to education, health, and economic empowerment.

Resort areas and tourist destinations in Mexico generally do not see the levels of drug-related violence and crime that are reported in the border region or in areas along major trafficking routes."" TOPIC	Playa Viva LLC is a Regenerative Luxury Boutique Hotel that operates an animal farm and has direct control over the treatment of animals in its care.
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	Playa Viva LLC has pigs, chickens and sheep on the farm. All are pasture raised and outdoors. All are fed a combination of compost from the kitchen along with organically and locally sourced corn feed. All are family farmed, not intensive, not indoors. The Playa Viva Permaculture Farm is to be considered an intensively grown regenerative farm. The animals are housed, fed and raised under the shade of certain hardwood species or the early stages of a food forest. Their pastures are enclosed with fencing or local materials, and their diets are managed by the members of the team. Chickens and sheep roam freely and have their pasture rotated weekly or biweekly, depending on the season. The diet of the chickens is supplemented with local corn.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	As of Fall 2022, the company has about 60 pigs, 30 chickens and 5 sheep.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Playa Viva LLC runs a regenerative farm on a small scale, and applies permaculture principles and syntropic models to the production systems. While the goal is for the farm to be self-sufficient, self-sustaining and even a profit center, eventually the plan is to spin off the farm as its own operating unit and business entity. One of the company's most popular excursions is the Permaculture Experience (farm tour), so the guests informally monitor the company's activities on a daily basis.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Regarding the animal welfare practices, the company affirmed that all animals are healthy, well-fed and clean. When pigs are "harvested" this is done by the Head of Permaculture who takes personal responsibility for making sure each final moment is made as quick and painless as possible for the animal. The company cross-breed local genetics with more industrial breed hogs, to ensure the best health of its animals and a sustainable weight gain during their lifecycle. Sheep graze under fruit trees serving as natural lawn mowers and fertilizing along the way. Chickens lay eggs for the hotel (staff and guest use) and also maintain pest populations in the food forest. Pigs are raised for protein for the hotel and "harvested" onsite in the most humane way. The chickens are enclosed in a chicken coop from 7pm until 7am for their own protection against predatory animals in the evenings. There are 2-3 birds per meter. Pigs have at least 100 square meters of free space per animal. All sheep have at least 100 square meters per animal.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a company that manages its own animal farm, Playa Viva LLC operates in an industry in which biodiversity impact is a material environmental issue.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Approximately 0.5% of Playa Viva's revenue comes directly from operating animal farms.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Animal agriculture poses a risk to local ecosystems of flora and fauna as well as the potential degradation of farmed land.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Playa Viva manages its impact to promote biodiversity. Farm operations are limited to specific areas. Non-farm areas and non-hotel areas are restored and regenerated through mangrove restoration, low coastal forest restoration and permaculture work in general. The company tracks these ecosystems and their rehabilitation by grokking the natural as well as changing rhythms of the land, and deploying permaculture strategies as needed.
	In the initial two years, Playa Viva created a nursery and planted close to 10,000 trees based on species that once defined this coastal forest as collected from the limited areas nearby that were not degraded. Over the last 14 years of operations, coastal forest and mangrove systems have rehabilitated their natural landscapes.
	The permaculture nature of the company's farming operations promotes multi-strata food forests and regenerative soil management techniques which also create habitat and food sources for large, small and microscopic species. The company creates all its own biofertilizers and biological treatments on site using plants already in the ecosystem. The company also uses native and biodiverse cover crops to manage farmed land and build soil; crops are rotated seasonally to ensure diverse flora and fauna inside our production systems, as well as to mitigate disease that might otherwise reproduce.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a company that manages its own animal farm, Playa Viva LLC operates in an industry that is water intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Approximately 0.5% of Playa Viva's revenue comes directly from operating animal farms.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water intensive industry, animal agriculture poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Playa Viva monitors the water used for the hotel and the farm. Water comes from reservoirs on the property which are maintained and refilled seasonally. The animals live under the shade of trees and agroforestry systems, and use very little water as an isolated system. When water is used to irrigate pasture for a short window during the dry season, it is the same water that nourishes and supports the fruit trees above the animals. Permaculture focuses on stacking functions: every element is used three times, at a minimum, inside a system or a combination of systems.
	The swales and keyline water systems on hillsides and throughout the property redirect precipitation to new and historic pond systems. Production zones are watered as minimally as possible through drip-irrigation.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a company that manages its own animal farm, Playa Viva LLC operates in an industry in which energy and carbon emissions is a material environmental issue.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Approximately 0.5% of Playa Viva's revenue comes directly from operating animal farms.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Animal agriculture is a major contributor to global carbon emissions.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	"Animal/protein production at Playa Viva is small scale. Carbon used to transport is minimal as protein goes to the hotel or is distributed to local residents purchasing a basket of farm fresh produce and protein (CSA style). Playa Viva's goal is to eventually be carbon neutral or even negative. The hotel is 100% off grid solar. All water is heated by solar thermal. On the farm, carbon/energy is used primarily via gasoline (carbon/petroleum based product) to run vehicles and pumps. Other than pumps and transport, fossil fuel and carbon is minimal on the farm. The company runs the hotel electricity through generating 100% of grid solar and heats all water
	with solar thermal. The only carbon/fossil fuel based energy at the hotel (and on the farm) is natural gas for cooking, gasoline for pumps and transportation/trucks. "

TOPIC	Playa Viva LLC operates in a area with sensitive ecosystems
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	The company's facilities are located nearby sensitive ecosystems such as: - Mangrove with protected species - covered under government requirements, - Marine Turtle Nesting Beach - Including Endangered and Protected Species, - Archeological sites.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The Regenerative Luxury Boutique Hotel is not located in sensitive ecosystems. The company is located adjacent to those protected ecosystems.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	The facilities are located inside protected/sensitive ecosystems which could potentially impact the flora, fauna and quality of the ecosystem (e.g. noise & light pollution from the facilities, spills, air / soil / water pollution owing to company's operations).
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	When Playa Viva undertook its development process, the company conducted due diligence with the Regenisis Group (leading regenerative development and design consultancy) team and a team of biologists, lawyers, and other specialists related to completing its Manifesto de Impacto Ambiental (Environmental impact assessment) - the required Environmental Impact Studies required by Federal Agencies. By doing this assessment, the company identified the sensitive areas and, under the limitations determined by the MIA (Environmental Impact Report) we located all buildings beyond the legal limit required by law from such sensitive areas, Playa Viva undertook any and all construction under the strict limitations of the environmental laws, any mangrove (sensitive area) restoration and regeneration, under the limitations set by the law and the environmental impact study. In summary, no work was done in sensitive areas other than what is allowed by law or the limitations of the environmental impact study and other work was done to restore any degraded areas surrounding sensitive areas. In terms of promoting biodiversity, Playa Viva LLC contributes to the: - Restoration and protection of mangroves by planting seedlings and removing invasive
	overgrowth and other debris (e.g. coconuts, coconut palm debris); diversification of plant and crop species, removing invasive species and planting native varieties, - Promotion of environmental awareness and environmentally conscientious behavior through educational activities and programs within the community, La Tortuga Viva, and among staff at Playa Viva, - Restoration of coastal forest ecosystems by rebuilding soils (organic farming) and contribution to erosion control, - Grow of edible and medicinal crops for consumption and for natural building material without the use of harmful/toxic pesticides, herbicides, insecticides,
	For the archeological sites, the company brought the INAH, the federal agency in charge of archaeological finds, and asked for approval on how to proceed. We identified the beach as a degraded low coastal forest for our own restoration outside of any protections required by any government agency, Playa Viva LLC owns a non-profit Foundation Tartle Sanctuary, focused on protecting endangered turtles. The company supports La Tortuga Viva (The Living Turtle), Juluchuca's local sea turtle conservation project.
