SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a agricultural company, Tierra Orgánica operates in an industry in which biodiversity impact is a material environmental issue.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Approximately 90% of Tierra Organica supplier expenses come directly from farms.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Agriculture poses a risk to local ecosystems of flora and fauna as well as the potential degradation of cultivated land.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Company has taken a position as they know the agricultural companies almost always have an impact on biodiversity, some of the reasons are the type of production based on the use of agrochemicals, large extensions, monoculture and the production vision of the companies. Tierra Organica treats organic lands which includes points in the following action steps: - Tierra Organica maintains a certified organic production based on the use of agricultural products made on the farm by farmers with natural ingredients. - The maximum extension of cultivation that each of the producers maintains is 5 hectares and the current average is 3. - Tierra Organica maintains mixed plantings on various farms to avoid monoculture, company does not use herbicides and in this way maintains soil cover. - Tierra Organica fumigates with microorganisms as part of the crop management plan, in order to take care of the soil and its life. - Tierra Orgánica's vision is that each of their producers improve their efficiency in the use of the land and receive better payments for production so that they do not have to plant large quantities, but instead have good productivity in small areas. - Tierra Organoca measures the average hac that farmers have, which by organic regulations cannot exceed 5 hac. - Tierra Organica maintains an organic certificate that prevents from using agrochemicals. - Increase the efficiency of production per hectare to avoid the deforestation of new areas by crops that do not produce adequately. - Tierra Organica controls the sowing processes of farmers so that they are volumes that can be marketed.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a agricultural company, Tierra Organica operates in an industry that is water intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Approximately 90% of Tierra Organica supplier expenses come directly from farms.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water intensive industry, agriculture poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. However, company is not located in a water stressed area, company is located at Ecuador coast.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Company's use of water is for the packing of fruit on one hand and on the other in the field for the dissolution of the inputs that they prepare on the farm with the farmers. In the first case they use water from the municipal system of El Carmen, in the second each farmer uses the water that is available near his plot. In some cases slopes or rivers. The average production area of our farmers is small, 3 hectares, so the use is not intensive. At the moment Tierra organica has not taken further measures since water consumption is controlled. However, the technical support they provide aims to optimize the use of water.
