Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Fossil Fuels

Topic	Company retails fossil fuels
Summary of Issue	Maganetti owns a LNG/CNG station to serve the geographical area where it operates. LNG is the least polluting fuel for heavy trucks available today. It is a retail location but for pre-authorized commercial operators (trucks and vans).
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Maganetti Spedizioni spa earns 3% of revenues from the sale of fossil fuels.
Impact on Stakeholders	The geographical area most affected by this kind of environmental output is the local community where Maganetti operates (Valtellina region).
Implemented Management Practices	Through this activity, Maganetti is actually already contributing to the reduction of negative environmental impacts related to the logistics sector, helping to build an infrastructure that allows the company and also its competitors to choose the least polluting fuel in this market. Maganetti is also implementing a conversion plan on the total owned fleet and on part of its affiliated fleet in order to reduce pollution (less CO2, less PMx).
Management Comments	The LNG station is already a step up from the classic diesel station but the aim is to get to the bioLNG

Topic	Energy and emissions intensive industry
Summary of Issue	As an industrial transport service provider, Maganetti Spedizioni provides road transport services, which are mainly based on the use of diesel. Therefore, the company operates in an industry in which energy and carbon emissions are material environmental issues.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company reported that it earned 100% of its last annual revenue from road transportation services. The main contribution to the company's emission of
	greenhouse gases is within its scope, which represents 100% of the total inventory. The company's assessed GHG emissions for [d] were 24.898 Co2/Kg for the year 2022
Impact on Stakeholders	Energy and emissions intensive industries contribute to air pollution and climate change. B Lab recognised the haulage and refrigerated storage industries as an energy intensive that will require the creation of additional risk standards through a standards development process.
Implemented Management Practices	 In order to reduce the negative impacts associated with its carbon emissions, the company reported the following practices As a less polluting replacement proposal, the company has activated a specific methane distributor for heavy vehicles (LNG) which until 2021 first operated exclusively and then mainly with fossil methane, Since 2022 following a biofuel project, the company has operated the distributor almost exclusively on biomethane, The company plans to open a second station in 2023, which will include both biomethane and fossil methane and, probably, HVO as a replacement fuel for diesel.
