Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Nuclear Power Industry

WattValue SARL reported that it works in the Nuclear Power Industry. This sector carries potential risks to the health and safety of employees and local communities as well as potential risks to the environment, including water and soil pollution, habitat disruption, and thermal pollution, which may affect local ecosystems and communities. Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Fossil Fuels

Issue Date	August 2025
Topic	The company manages energy contracts (business consultancy) for clients that come from both renewable and non renewable sources. WattValue also negotiates and manages contracts over their lifetime (pricing, consumption alerts, invoicing verification, optimisation).
Summary of Issue	WattValue offers contract negotiations services for electricity (renewable and non renewable) and gas. They also sell GOs or 'Guarantie D'Origine' which are certificates for energy that guarantees its origin is from renewable sources.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The sale of Guarantie D'Origine (GO) certificates constitutes 68% of the revenues, representing 100% green electricity. Unlike in previous years, no biogas was included in the negotiated volumes. Contract negotiations for electricity and gas accounted for approximately 30% of revenues. The majority of non-renewable electricity on the French grid is generated from nuclear sources.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	WattValue promotes the sale of green electricity and biogas. The use of these green energy sources is a voluntary action that comes at an additional cost to their customers. In the past, biogas represented one-third of the negotiated volume; however, for fiscal year 2024, this amount has fallen to zero due to the energy crisis. For green electricity, approximately 10% of the negotiated volume corresponds to green sources. Additionally, the company sells GOs for a total
	volume of about 300 GWh.
Implemented Management Practices	The company has two types of customers: GO only customers and non GO customers. For the non GO customers, the company systematically proposes 25%, 50% or 100% GO in their contract and also promotes GO on their website. The company offer of "Garantie d'origine électricité" is featured on search engines and the company publishes articles and news on a quarterly basis to their customers. Since 2021, the company has offered near-real-time alerts and hourly electricity consumption monitoring to promote energy consumption



	reduction.

Other Management Comments	The company has been active in green certificates since 2006. It was their main business for 6 years. They started with RECS certificates. This is part of their core values. They also worked with their office tenants to also use 100% green electricity.
