Торіс	Sharing User Data to Advertising Partners and Third Parties
Summary of Issue	Nomad Education has a yearly partnership agreement with different commercial partners. As part of the agreement, Nomad Education shares user data with their partners in exchange for 50% of the revenue generated through the partnership. There are two ways in which data can be shared:
	 Linking: Nomad Education shares the user's personal data with a partner only with the user's consent. This allows the partner to offer their services, such as training or language stays, to the user.
	 Visibility: Nomad Education promotes the partner on various platforms, including advertising banners, mini-apps, sponsored content, and push notifications. Nomad Education sets up and manages the visibility campaign on behalf of the partner.
	Nomad Education collects personal information from users such as name, first name, email, desired fields of study and areas of interest, and optionally telephone number.
	Nomad Education only uses cookies on their website for connection management purposes, specifically for user identification, and they do not use any information from these cookies to generate revenue.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In 2022, Nomad Education received 28,5% of its annual revenue from advertising which involved sharing user data with third parties.
Impact on Stakeholders	Nomad Education provides Privacy and security policy available inlute at https://www.nomadeducation.fr/conditions-d-utilisation . This policy explains the personal data collected by the company, the purpose of data collection, and the rights of the users to access information, rectify, delete, limit, oppose, and



	transfer their personal data. The policy also covers tracers and personal data, data transfer and conservation.
Implemented Management Practices	Nomad Education is fully compliant with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The company has the support of a lawyer who specializes in data management and compliance, in order to follow national and international legislation. Additionally, the company has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who is responsible for ensuring compliance with the GDPR and the recommendations of the CNIL .
	All partners are required to sign GDPR clauses. These clauses indicate the conditions of use and their commitments regarding the personal data they receive.
	Nomad Education is currently working on a project to provide each user with a list of partners that correspond to their connection. The list will be accessible by clicking on the list of partners on the user's consent opt-in page for sharing their data with partners. The company expects to finalize this project by February 2024
